EMBRACING CHANGE

To honor the many transitions taking place at the end of this academic year, the Women’s Choir is presenting a program dedicated to embracing change. We open with the intense writings of Mary Queen of Scots, composed while she was imprisoned and awaiting her beheading. *Cúnnla* emphatically speaks to the boundaries we create when romantic relationships suddenly turn sour. Three of our songs speak to the challenges of moving ahead into the unknown. *Remember Rainier* (composed specifically for this concert) highlights how bittersweet it will be to leave Seattle; *The Lake Isle of Innisfree* focuses on the strength that can be found in the solitude of the unknown; and, while we do not always know the impact we have upon others, *The Arrow & the Song* speaks to a pervasive interconnectedness. After successfully embracing many challenges, *Vay’chulu* serves as a celebration of accomplishment.
