E. at 6 3/4 AM. came on board, We have hauled out to let the Mossul get in, as we have finished discharging (having only 382 packages), --- Capt Holland is in an awful way about our runing from Basreh to Amara only & he cannot make out why Blockey wishes it so & without consulting with him & ask his advise, Holland says that he can come up with 40,000 Akes very well; Left at 8 called on Sayegh & left at 92 went home, at 102 called on EM. sat in serdab talked & read in the Iwan, left at 32 P. Sayegh called on me, at 12 the S. V. Comet" went down to lay up at Gherarah for about 15 days & encamp there: ---Light S. Ely breeze & calm day; Mr. Arteen Erame & Elias Serkis are going down with us to Garua they have taken 1st C. Cabin, Mr. Johnston of Hector & Janny Demarki are going to Basreh in a 2d C. Cabin, an other cabin forward is let to Hassan Bey's wife for Amara, and Saleh Hamed also in 2d C. Cabin, We have great many passengers our Deck is full; and are deep with cargo we have over 32,000 Akes all Bale goods and other things; --- Left the ship at 5 P. M. called on EM. for 1 hour & went home dined with Henry & my father and at 62 called on EM. on the terrace took the Letters, nige cool N. W. breeze; left at 112 & came on board slept in the cabin,

V. Phrate passed up she touched a little & went over being very light, Weighed & proceeded down At 10.15 --- At 11 came to the shoal at the Popular Grove & grounded there sent

Comet came down with the kit and family of the Ships crew to encamp at Gherarah, she tryed to pass between us & the Island but stuck and Swang round with her Port broadside on our bow & remained so, she then took an anchor out & hove up then dropped down between us & the Island & left at 10 I sent a letter to Emilia with Pais to Gherara. --- We have and hove & shifted anchors but to no use, discharged more cargo & the last of it at 4 P. M., some few passengers returned to Baghdad, this is an awful bad stick; At 5 P. M. we hove over and dropped down, there is an other shoal further down. we stuck in it & took anchors out to swing her head down stream, our passengers who are half left on shore commenced to growl & want to come on board we brought them at 10 P. M. & begun heaving again; floated & dropped down at 11 & went

M. passed Ctesiphon, at 1.30 grounded at Semrah run an anchor out astern & hove her out: We have altogether 251 passengers and 8 for Amara of the City of London of last trip (Hassan Bey & family) At 2.30 weighed and proceeded down; --- At 4.55 came to at Awein & sent to sound I had to live the Luggage of the passengers half weighed. found 21 draaz at 61 weighed, steamed to the shoal, having put a camp Signal in the punt right ahead but grounded on it; We remained aground for the night without heaving. Light N. W. & cold morning, at sunrise begun heaving, landed passengers, at 9 floated & dropped down, stuck again broke the chain of the stern anchor, sent to pick it up, We rounded & came to by a bower anchor, but her head grounded; took anchor out & hove into deep water took in the passengers & left at Ø.15 P. M.; Weighed the remainder of the passeng Luggage; --- at 3.30 P. M. passed Baghdadieh; --- At 5.15 came to at Sened Captain & Pilot went in the Punt to sound; came back at 8 found 21 draaz, Got a Wood Boat to discharge cargo hired for 50 Beshlic we hauled alongside the bank about 100 Yards above to where the sunken boat is & put plank out our passengers fell upon the Cultwation of Lubias like so many locusts

and pluked all the Lubias & destroyed the Cultivation, Capt Holland came back at 8 P. M. & found only 24 draz, We discharged cargo into the boat during the night & left her alongside for the night,

27th Satur Light N. W. & fine, I was troubled awfully last night by the sunflies from the bank my cabin was full & could not sleep. at 5 AM. sent the Boat with Cargo to the other side passed the shoal, at 6 I went out shooting taking one man Mossully passenger with me walked up river, Mr. Johnston & Hardie also went but downward river, I started a great many partridges had 28 Cartridges with me walked outside the Jungle then up alongside the bank cultivated by Lubia but now getting dry it is being picked by Arab women & bitten down to get the seed out, I had a good sport there, came back on board at 9 with 19 partridges & 2 lost, Hardie brought 9 and a Hare & Johnston 3 partridges only I did not undress but after having had my breakfast at 11 started again taking with me an Arab of the Shemmer, (Mejableh tribe) and walked along the bank then inside in the Jungle; There is a Lion here ahead of me in the thick Jungle he was heard near the Arab Camp about 5 days ago, & so the Arab did not advise me to go further up, walked backward & forward, had a watermelon with me, ate it @] P. M. Very cool & nice it was, & walked on but in the afternoon I could not find many birds & scarcely one could I see after much trouble & walk, sat & had a rest for 1 hour & continued again, the Dijleh after discharging all her cargo, saw her proceeding on to the shoal & grounded on it, I came to the

went out there were Mr. Johnstone Mr. Knight Hardie & myself I took 15 Cartridges with me each of them had a servant I had no body I saw a pretty good number, after walking in land & down river I shot 10 but lost 2, and my cartridges were done, I had to come back at 11, Hardie brought 9 Mr. Knight 2 & Mr. Johnstome none; --- At Ø.30 P. M. we weighed & proceeded down; at 1.15 came to off Goobba to take in some coal we had left some time ago for the Despatch about a ton, & many passengers went on shore to buy Bread; At 3 proceeded from Goobba, At 3½ Grounded at Zweyet el Zereh; took out three anchors and hove her into deep water, We had no business to ground here; at 6 P. M. floated gathered anchors & left at 6.30, --- Light N. W. & fine cool bfeeze; ---

M; at 2.30 passed the S. TelAffer going up, reported 21 dragz at the Cut as before, At 3 came to above the Cut, Capt Holland went to sound and landed all the passengers, I walked also down with my snider rifle with Janny Demarki & Mr. Johnstone, went through the Jungle started 2 or three Pigs but I could not get a shot at them; at 5 the Dijleh steamed down passed the cut there is 21 draaz good in it & the ship is drawing now 3 feet 9 Inches, came to alongside took in the passengers and left at 5.20 P. M. passed Ali Gharhi; Calm Weather with light S. Ely breeze,

At 9 P. M. arrived to Amara landed 58 passengers and 147 Packages, I went on shore to see Fattralla before giving the cargo, Jeboari and Michaul are gone today out in the desert to see their sheep, Michaul has left me a letter with the

servant of Fattralla Alias & the Box of sweetmeat (Maamool) which he had brought down with him for me from Eliza, Fattralla tells me that he is not going to send up Michaul now to Baghdad until his health is well regained that he is still weak & that he is not of much requisite to Eliza there, I left him soon & came to give the cargo, which is so mixed up with the other and in every hold there is little I had great bother with it: ---

M. proceeded. --- detained 45 minutes aground below the Devil's Elbow, she run over a shoal ful power & swung round. --- At 6.30 passed Azeir, at 9.40 arrived to Garua landed 55 packages and 22 passengers, (Elias Serkis & Arteen Erame also landed here) I finished Cargo at $12\frac{1}{2}$ P. I took a cold water bath, Mr. Wortmann came to see me. --- We are taking 10 tons of coal to be put in a Boat which we hired & are to tow her up with us; --- At 5.15 the City of London left Coot, --- At 5.40 the Dijleh left, after 5 minutes grounded between the two islands & had to take an anchor out to move her into deep water, at 6½ proceeded & after 5 minutes again grounded over a shoal, sent to sound & took anchors ahead & hove, at 10 --- proceeded with the Boat in tow, --- detained ½ hour at Umel Boonni sounding (3 draaz water) --- Light N. W. & fine cold morning, at 4 AM. the ship in steaming at Umhat el Ajaj, the Boat in tow took the ground and her bow & rudder was tore to pieces & most fell down, anchored

I crossed to the East bank to shoot took an Arab passenger with me, & took my both Guns the Muzle & breach loader, there I took two more Arabs with me but I was most awfully disappointed on finding that all my cartridges I had filled with a very bad powder that made no noise & left a green colour in the barrel, I could not heat with it I expended about 30 shots & had only got 12 partridges, when I wanted to take the Muzzle gun I found that my Arab had lost the

powder flask in the Jungle, he had one of his own with some powder intit, I used & returned on board at 5½ with 23 partridges; We landed passengers, emptied one Boiler & took anchors ahead & hove her over 2½ draz, but she wont go, commenced discharging cargo on the West bank & landed the coal, took it over to the other side by our Boat hired from Coot; Knocked off landing cargo at about 11 P. M;

12th Sunday Light N. W. & fine cool morning but calm, at 5 AM. I got up, feeling verytyred, dressed for shooting, I want to send my partridges to Baghdad if we stick here, at 6 crossed to the other side Hardie with me one fireman & an Arab passenger I took with me, met on the East bank near the sunken boat, my Arab companion called Shery sent him to get me a Horse to send to Baghdad, he sent an Arab to Azizieh to get me me one from there, We walked on but did not put up many partridges, I walked up to my place, Hardie returned walking down by the river side & I walked up, & walked every where inland & on the bank but I do not see now so many partridges as before, they have been frightened I suppose I had the two guns with me, & I must say the muzzle one shoots much better & carries further, I shot two partridges with one shot on the bank of the river where beans has been cultivated & were walking on the ground, I at last came back to the ship at 11 AM. it being hot, the ship had got over and is now alongside the east bank taking in coal & cargo, I shot altogether 33 partridges including 6 which I lost in Jungle, Hardie had shot only 5, but I suffered awfully & walked 5 hours in one stretch in the thick Jungle I nearly lost my my breath sometimes, I have shot altogether this trip down & up 115 partridges

Clouds appeared on the N. & N. W. quarters coming over apparently signs of rainy Weather; --- At 5.30 P. M. after finishing with the taking in the cargo Got under weigh from Sened; --- from 6 to 6½ were detained taking off a broken float --- At 8.45 passed Baghdadieh Fort;

13th Mond

Light N. W. & little cloudy at 1.15 AM. came to at Awein. sent to sound & came after long time, there are 3 draaz, At 7 proceeded, but touched over the shoal steamed over it & proceeded at 7.40; at 11.45 came to at Joarf el Batha to take off a Broken float & put in a new one left At 0.45 P. M; At 2.45 came to at Gusseiba & sent to sound; found 21 draaz, landed the passengers, at 3½ I left the ship with my gun, took an Arab passenger who carried the 45 partridges I had shot at Sened, & walked in, Dowd ferrani a servant of Capt Powell formerly, he also walked in with me; crossed Diala by 5, hired Arab Donkeys I got one also for 1 Beshlic to Baghdad & spread all the partridges on its back & walked as hard as I could we got to Blockeys tents below Gherarah at 6.20, all my sisters are out, Fettochi Kesberkhan is also encamped, Stifan and Maduli, & Emilia with Alice were with them; I stopped about 5 minutes gave to Blockey his letters, had a glass of Brandy & water & started for Bashdad Weather cloudy, had few drops of rain in the desert & in Baghdad; at about 7 I met the S. Tell Affer" going down just at Gherarah, with the Governor

of Baghdad Redif Pasha on board going to Garua & Nassryeh to see the Sudd of the Euphrates at 8 I arrived home having hired a white donkey at half way & rode him with 22 partridges with me (24 I had given to my sisters, at the tents) & galloped fast to the house I was awfully tyred, Henry his wife & my father are at home, I immediately sent 5 partridges to Eliza Marine & 5 to Sayegh & went to see Eliza with her letters, she is asleep on the top of the house yet but shifted beds to the other lower terrace, all the rest of the people are descending down below but few are up yet, my father Henry & his wife are also down, had a long talk & then left at 9, came home had a warm bath & dined at 11 & slept on the top of the house nice cool weather;

14th Tuesd Light N. W. & fine cool breeze, at 7 AM. called on Sayegh; and at 10 called on EMaine, as our breakfast was not ready, I was forced by Eliza to breakfast with them & so remained; at 12 my servant Hamadi came to me he landed from the Popular Grove where the Dijleh got aground, she had arrived to Gherarah last night at 9½ P. M. & remained at anchor there, & left this morning, Blockey Carolina & Emilia are coming up in her; she arrived to Baghdad at 1 P. M. this afternoon at 4½ I left Eliza & came home found Emilia & Carolina at the door leaving to go back to Gherarah overland they stopped about 5 minutes & went away, after diner I called on Sayegh from the terrace passed over had a talk with Eliza & then went down below they are sleeping down CatherinaYaghchi was there left at 9 came

15th Wednes home; Modte N. W. breeze & fine ---

Light N. W. & fine breeze at 7 AM. I came on board; We have commenced discharging cargo;

My Servant Hamadi came to me this morning on board & when I asked him why he did not call home this morning as I wanted to bring something on board, he said that he is not going to come any more here or at the house I said allright if you want to leave you can, & so I paid him his wages up to the 15th Instt & he went away; I wrote a little and at 11 went to breakfast, at 12 called on EMain sat in Iwan; retook my Turkish & English pounds back from her which I had put on 2d Sept. with her, read in Iwan, left @ 4½ P. M. came home, Henry & his wife went out at 5, Henry went to shoot at Ctesiphon & his wife went to Gherarah after diner I called at 6½ on EMain on the terrace had a walk & left at 11½ fine cool night but calm dampy weather; ---

16th Thursd Light N. W. & fine cool morning at 7 AM. came on board, wrote for Capt Holland a letter to Colonel Herbert regarding his claim of wood taken by the Turks etc. left at 8½ went to the bazars; bought some kit for Mr. Robertson & for Antone Marine, went home at 11 called on Sayegh, & at 12½ called on EMain she is not well has cold & stomach & head ach, & feels feverish is in bed in Iwan left at 3 P. M. went to the bazar got some more kit for Antone & returned to Eliza with Roofaul at 4, Yousef Sayegh came there left at 4½ & at 5 I rode a donkey & went out to Gherarah, saw my sisters & Blockey, saw there Capt Powell Fitzgeråld & Mr. Clerk, I dined with Stifan &

Maduli & slept outside the tents, I spoke with Blockey regarding my servant Hamadi who left me, etc,

17 Friday Light N. W. breeze, at 5 AM. I got up t come in, when I saw Henry coming back from Ctesiphon, he could not shoot many partridges he brought about 22 but he only shot about 10, he says there are too many shooters Arabs all carry double barreled Guns, & the birds have got wild, I rode in at 5½ arrived to Baghdad at 61 (sunrise), dressed & left at 7 called on EM. to see her for 10 minutes & came on board; We have finished discharge & hauled off, there are no other steamers here by the "Dijleh"; I counted the ships money about 3,000 Beshlics & took them myself to the Office to Blockey at about 92 saw Blockey & Fitzgerald in office left & came to the bazaar to buy some kit for Robertson went home to breakfast at 11 at 12 called on EM she is better but has still cold in bones etc: at 5 P. M. left came home after dinner called on Sayegh there were Roofaul Yaghchi & his wife, took to Sussan the bond & interest on her 30 Liras I put for her on Interest @ 1% with Yacoob our Serraf today for 3 months; --- left at 91 Cloudy weather all over & light S. Ely breeze;

18th Satur Modte S. Ely breeze & cloudy all over, at $7\frac{1}{4}$ AM. came on board, took Muray the Jenahi our former Servant who used to be at my brother Tomaso to serve me for the present until I find a good one; --- left @ 9 been in the bazaar for Robertsons kit as Blue Clothe for Kawasses chintzes pipes etc; Went home, at $\emptyset.30$ P. M. called on EM. she was in bath at home came out after $\frac{1}{2}$ hour, Henry came in from Gherarah this morning, left

Eliza at 4 P. M. came home, cleaned my Kefeshkan & had it swept, Henry went out to Gherarah at 5 P. M. I had a warm bath, The S. "Mossul" arrived from Basreh at 1 P. M. Arteen Brame & Arteen Apikyan came up in her; at 6½ I called on EMain still on top of the house, passed the evening, cloudy weather thretening with very light S. Ely breeze, left at 11 P. M. came home slept on the top of the house yet, every body has gone in ---Modte S. Ely & cloudy --- at 7½ AM. I went to the Latin Church the Assyrian Bishop was predicting at 10 called on Sayegh, & left @ 12 called on EM. there came Y. Sayegh for ½ hour, Eliza does not feel well, Giddy & headach; left at 5½ P. M. came home, After dinner called on Sayegh there came Eliza Marine passed the evening & We left at 9, Modte S. Ely wind and cloudy night;

20th Mond

19th

Sunday

Modte S. Ely breeze & cloudy at $7\frac{1}{2}$ AM. came on board Many passengers came on board, We are taking cargo at 10 Akes per 1 Beshlic; Serry Effendi's wife daughter & an other female have taken two cabins aft going to Amara, Haji Abdulkadur Effendi of Basreh Custom house & his wife taken a cabin aft going down free, Mr. Pritchard clerk of Tambaci & a Turk Abdulla Bey also have taken 1st C. Cabin, At 10 went home breakfasted & at 11 called on EM. sat in room, left @ 12½ came on board, we are taking a lot of cargo, but not over 10,000 Akes for the present; --- all 3 cabins forward are taken, Hannosh Kroonir & his sister in law, Hannah Nakar Saleh Assafi & two persians in 2d C. Cabins --- Worked hard till 5 P. M. --- Cloudy Weather & S. Ely breeze, --- at 6 I went home saw Y. Sayegh ther after diner at $7\frac{1}{2}$ I called

on EM. on the top of the house Weather cloudy & few drops of rain fell; at $10\frac{1}{2}$ heard the Whissle of the "City of London arrived; breeze shifted to a N. W. breeze, had a long talk & we got vexed left at $11\frac{1}{2}$ with the letters & came on board, great confusion aft with the family of Serry Effendi etc; ---

Baghdad to Basreh

21st Tuesd

Light N.W. & fine, at 6.15 AM. got under weigh from Baghdad I took Muray as Servant with me; --- I have a bad head ache, At 8.10 passed the Comet & Tents at Cherarah saw all my sisters there Gave tickets to passengers At 9.30 came to at Gusseiba sent to sound & landed all the passengers; --- steamed over the shoal touched but got clear, took the passengers in and left at Ø.20 P. M; at 1. P. M. came to at Barooda to take in 20 Horses at 50 Besh: per head shipped through; --- At 3.30 got under weigh from Selencia overhauled the passengers We have altogether 213½ passengers, (Haji Effendi his wife & 4 servants are free) --- detained 15 m. at Semrah reach getting through intricate chanel, At 6.50 came to an anchor for the night below Ledj reach, fine clear night with Light N.W. breeze & cool; ---

22d Wednes

Thm @6. 62 noon 85 4 P. M. 86 Light N. W. & fine cold morning at 6.15 AM. got under weigh from Ledj & came to at Awein sounded, took an anchor out astern & hove her round & over the shoal, at 7.50 proceeded from Awein; --- at 10.40 passed Baghdadieh, commenced weighing the passengers luggage; Sent Meekha Tindal to assist Muray & shew him, great lot of Luggage weighed, At Ø.20 P. M. came to at Abdulla & sent the Pilot to sound & landed the

passengers I finished weighing at 12, but they used to take

the Deckmen always to some work etc etc; --- at 2 proceeded

to the shoal & steamed over 21 draaz got over at 2.40 and at

23d Thurs Thm @6. 64 noon 84 4 P. M. 88 3 anchored below Sened to take in the passengers, at 4.45 proceeded from Azizieh, Fattralla Bey the Kaymakam of this place has died a few days ago and was buried at Selman Pak; also Moorad Effendi (formerly Governor of Amara) died in Baghdad about 10 days ago, his wealth was found to be about 40,000 % he was inherited by his only son --- Light N. W. and fine. --- at 5.15 grounded near Zewiyat Zereh took an anchor astern & hove out at 5.40 proceeded --- At 7 came to at Shejir & sent to sound, at 8 proceeded over the shoal of 2 3/4 & 3 draz, passed it with a signal of light in the punt & came to for the night; --- Light breeze & fine, Light N. W. with few clouds, at 6 AM. got under weigh from Shejir but soon after grounded run an anchor out astern & hove her out, at 6.50 proceeded, At 1 P. M. passed Memlah Station; --- At Young Pig was struggling to get out of the East bank at Hamrayeh and I shot him dead with my snider & was left there; at 3 P. M. passed the S. Telaffer™ going down left Baghdad on the 13th Inst with Radif Pasha but he was met by the "Ressafah" which came up & took him down to Nasryeh, We stopped & picked the Clerk of Telaffer going to Coot, took him free of passage money --- At 7 P. M. We came to alongside below Coot, landed 12½ passenger & took in 5 tons of coal brought down in Faffas --- Fahad Pasha (the sheikh of Montefig formerly) has presented Radif Pasha with 4 magnificent Horses
