Grenade Attack**

On Sunday March 30, 1997 unidentified men threw grenades into a crowd of peaceful demonstrators gathered outside the National Assembly in Phnom Penh. At least 15 people were killed and more than 150 wounded.

Yesterday LICADHO visited all hospitals and other places in Phnom Penh where the dying and wounded people had been taken. LICADHO found that there are urgent needs for medicines, food, clothing and other kinds of assistance for the victims and their families.

LICADHO therefore appeals to all individuals, NGOs and international donors to make financial or in-kind donations to assist the victims and their families.

LICADHO also asks all hospitals in Phnom Penh who are in need of any kind of assistance to immediately contact LICADHO.
