[Redacted] Comment: On 19 February the National University of El Salvador (UES) held elections for rector, vice-rector, university treasurer, and deans and vice-deans of six of the eight university faculties. Elected to the higher university positions were Rafael ~~M e n j i v a r a~~ Choto, the University Rector; ~~D r. J o s e N a p o l e o n R o d r i g u e z~~ Ruiz, Jr., the UES Vice-Rector; and ~~D r. L u i s E r n e s t o A r e v a l o~~, the University Treasurer. Elected respectively as deans and vice-deans of five of the faculties were: ~~D r. J o s e N a p o l e o n R o d r i g u e z~~ Ruiz, Sr. and ~~G a b r i e l G a l l e g o s V a l d e s~~ in the law faculty; ~~C a r l o s A b a r c a~~ and ~~J o r g e A l b e r t o E s c o b a r~~ in the economics faculty; ~~R a u l A r e v a l o~~ and ~~E l i z a b e t h S o r i a n o d e H e r n a n d e z~~ in the chemical sciences faculty; ~~D r. A d r i a n o V i l a n o v a~~ and ~~D r. J o a q u i n P a z S a n c h e z~~ in the dental faculty; and, lastly, ~~D r. R a f a e l A n t o n i o C e d i l l o s~~ and ~~D r. P e d r o R a m o n U r q u i l l a~~ in the faculty of medicine. The elections took place in the University General Assembly. The representatives of the Federation of Professional Associations of El Salvador (FAPES) walked out of the meeting when they learned that the vote would not be by secret ballot. Their absence did not interfere with the elections, however, since a quorum remained in the assembly.
