1. The Sixth Congress of the Unifying Federation of Salvadoran Unions (FUSS), the Communist dominated Salvadoran labor federation, was held on 12 - 13 September 1970. The goals set forth at the congress for the coming year are as follows:

- (a) Continue the fight against North American imperialism
- (b) Work for the nationalization of foreign business
- (c) Develop and defend Salvadoran industry
- (d) Fight unemployment
- (e) Apply pressure to attain true agrarian reform
- (f) Demand a minimum salary and an extension of social security
- (g) Seek the political and economic independence of El Salvador
