### Germany Donates 240,000 German Marks for Flood Victims

The Government of the Federal Republic of Germany will provide funds of

**240.000,-- German marks**

(approx. USD 115,500) to regions in Cambodia struck by recent floodings. The funds will be used for the purchase of 500 mt of rice. The German Agency for Technical Cooperation, GTZ, within its project „**Integrated Food Security Program in Kampot**“, is mandated to implement the aid in close cooperation with the competent Cambodian authorities.

Germany will thus continue its ongoing humanitarian assistance to the victims of last year's flooding. This time's donation is additional to the emergency relief package worth more than 17,5 million German marks committed by H.E. Mrs. Heidemarie Wieczorek-Zeul, German Federal Minister for Economic Cooperation and Development, during her visit to Cambodia from 7 to 9 October 2000.
