 4. THE FORMAT OUTLINED ABOVE WILL BE USED TO THE MAXIMUM POSSIBLE TO PORTRAY THE CURRENT SITUATION, IDENTIFY CINC CONCERNS, AND REPORT DEVELOPING PROBLEM AREAS UNDER THE TOTAL FORCE CONCEPT. IT

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 EMPHASIZES SIGNIFICANCE AND ALLOWS CINCS TO HIGHLIGHT MAJOR CONCERNS FOR HIGH LEVEL ATTENTION. HOWEVER, INFORMATION MUST BE PRESENTED IN SUFFICIENT QUALITATIVE AND QUANTITATIVE DETAIL TO ASSIST THE OJCS IN ASSESSING THE DEGREE TO WHICH PROGRAMS AND BUDGETS PROVIDE FUNDING TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE SIGNIFICANT CAPABILITY SHORTFALLS OF CONCERN TO THE JCS AND THE CINCS. ACCORDINGLY, A PRIORITIZATION OF CRITICAL REQUIREMENTS TO WARFIGHTING MISSION ACCOMPLISHMENT WILL BE MOST HELPFUL.
