With over 80 performances to his credit, including 40 leading characters, AUGUSTO PAGLIALUNGA is equally adept on the concert and oratorio platform, as well as the opera theater stage. Since receiving his Master of Music degree from the New England Conservatory of Music, he has had extensive experience in both the field of education and on the operatic stages of Europe and America. His teaching experience encompasses all levels of education: elementary, junior and senior high, and college. After several years of teaching and performing in Europe, he joined the University of Washington faculty in 1978. Since that time, Paglialonga has continued an active performance career, including a debut and subsequent performances with the New York City Opera, and his students have met with great success in competition and performance.

LARRY STARR is an Associate Professor and Head of the Division of Historical Musicology at the School of Music. During his ten years at the University of Washington, the basic focus of his research has been Twentieth Century American music. He is the author of several published articles on the works of Ives, Copland, and Gershwin. He has also worked as an accompanist with singers in the Seattle area and with the University of Washington Collegium Musicum, specializing in American song of all types.
