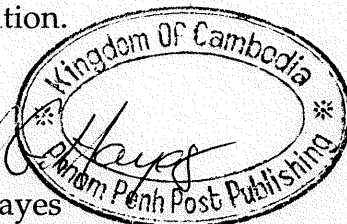
For your information, both the IMMF and the Phnom Penh Post will guarantee Mr. Channo's financial expenses during his stay in Thailand.
