2. ~~Jorge Shafick H and a l~~, Secretary General of the Communist Party of El Salvador (PCES), is making every effort to assure at least minimal PCES strength within the National University of El Salvador (UES) when the latter finally re-opens. At the same time, students and professors associated with the extreme left are also attempting to assure their return to the University; and to this end, they have been ordered to cooperate with present UES authorities in every way, to accept re-employment or re-admission to the UES on almost any terms, and generally to do whatever is necessary to maintain their association with the UES.

4. The PCES and the extreme left are attempting to organize students expecting to enter the UES on as broad a political basis as possible to gain as strong a position as possible within the student body as soon as the UES reopens.

Recognizing that the Government of El Salvador (GOES) may not allow students clearly associated with the PCES or the extreme left to return to the UES, every effort is being made to organize UES students in such a way that all of the forces which formerly made up the National Opposition Union (UNO) will be represented. It is hoped that this effort will thus expand PCES and extreme left influence among UES students, and permit them to exert influence in sectors not strictly associated with either of these two leftist groupings.
