This early five-voice motet clearly exhibits the composer's abiding predilection for contrapuntal setting of German chorale melodies. The motet begins with a rich but simple setting of the chorale, followed by extended elaboration of the chorale in soprano, alto, tenor and bass while the fifth voice, the baritone, carries the sustained chorale melody.

Die Beredsamkeit FRANZ JOSEPH HAYDN (1732-1809)
