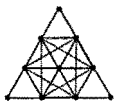

John Wilmot, All My Past Life...

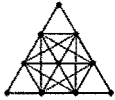
*All my past life is mine no more,

Phyllis, is wholly thine.*

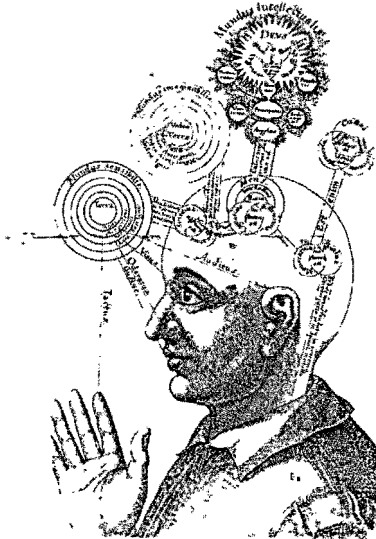
*Then talk not of inconstancy,
