2. The election for Rector of the National University of El Salvador (UES) is scheduled for February 1971 and candidates are becoming increasingly active on the campus. Among the candidates are Maria Isabel ~~X~~ ~~rodriguez de Sutter~~, Dean of the Medical School; Dr. Rafael ~~X~~ ~~Menjivar~~, an economics professor and former member of the Communist Party of El Salvador (PCES); and Fabio ~~X~~ ~~Castillo Figueroa~~, former UES Rector and well-known extreme leftist leader at the UES. The PCES is cautiously approaching each candidate while keeping a vigilant eye on student opinion. The party is inclined to support Menjivar. However, party leaders will not endorse him until more student polls are taken. Of the three candidates, Menjivar appears to be the easiest to control. The party wishes to back the most popular candidate among the students so as not to endanger its image on campus.
