

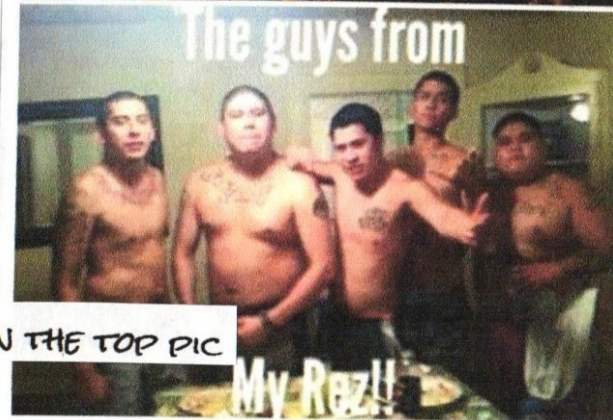
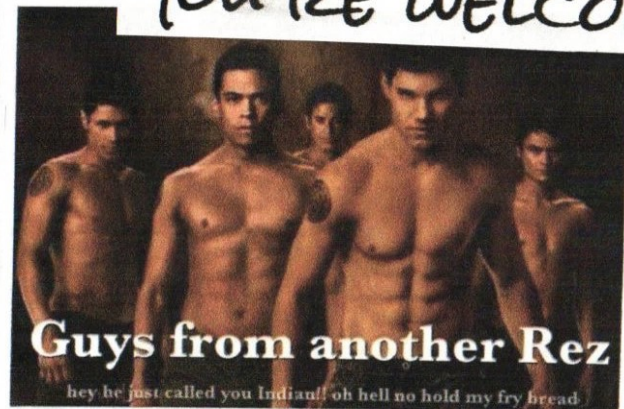
Umm..sorry not sorry!
