AWARE OF THE POLITICAL SENSITIVITIES INVOLVED, MINISTER OF DEFENSE AND PUBLIC SECURITY GENERAL CARLOS EUGENIO ((VIDES)) CASANOVA DID NOT MEET WITH THE SOUTH AFRICAN OFFICERS AS ORIGINALLY PLANNED AND ORDERED THAT THE DELEGATION BE GIVEN LOW-KEY TREATMENT.
