Under Japan's economic cooperation framework, *the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects ("KUSANONE" Grant) and Grant Assistance for Japanese NGO's Projects*, the Government of Japan will provide a total of 888,091USD to local authorities and non-governmental organizations.

1. US\$55,562 for the Project for Construction of Rainwater Tanks in Svay Chek District, Banteay Meanchey Province
