The Government of Japan has decided to provide a total amount of US\$ 287,857 to 6 projects, detailed further below, through its Grant Assistance for Grassroots/Human Security Projects (KUSANONE or Grassroots Grant).

1. US\$55,447 for the Project for Constructing School Buildings at Trapaing Phlong and Trapaing Thna Primary School in Svay Rieng Province
Recipient: *Provincial Department of Education, Youth and Sports of Svay Rieng*
2. US\$75,828 for the Project for Constructing Drainage in Stung Treng District, Stung Treng Province
Recipient: *Department of Public Works and Transport of Stung Treng Province*
3. US\$89,975 for the Project for Constructing Health Posts in Ratanakiri Province
Recipient: *Health Net International*
4. US\$33,647 for the Project for Constructing Phsa Prum Health Center in Pailin

5. US\$21,558 for the Project for Constructing Borey Chalusar Health Post in Takeo Province
Recipient: *Swiss Red Cross*
6. US\$11,402 for the Project for Aquaculture Farm Construction in Sihanoukville Municipality
