LAUNCHING REPORT ON "STOP VIOLENCE AGAINST US" PART II

"Stop Violence against Us!" Part II has been done to explore how violence affects children in Cambodia from their perspective and looks at the prevalence of the problem.

This report was initially co-funded by the British Embassy Phnom Penh, First Presbyterian Church, Berkeley, Justice for Children International, Tearfund UK, World Hope and World Vision.

The first report focused on three aspects of the problem of violence against children; sexual abuse, corporal punishment and domestic violence against children. This second report is an attempt to establish the prevalence of three other aspects of violence against children; trafficking of children, bullying and gang violence against adults. Both reports are an attempt to listen to children's own perceptions and to continue to explore their ideas on how these issues can be addressed.
