Enclosed please find:

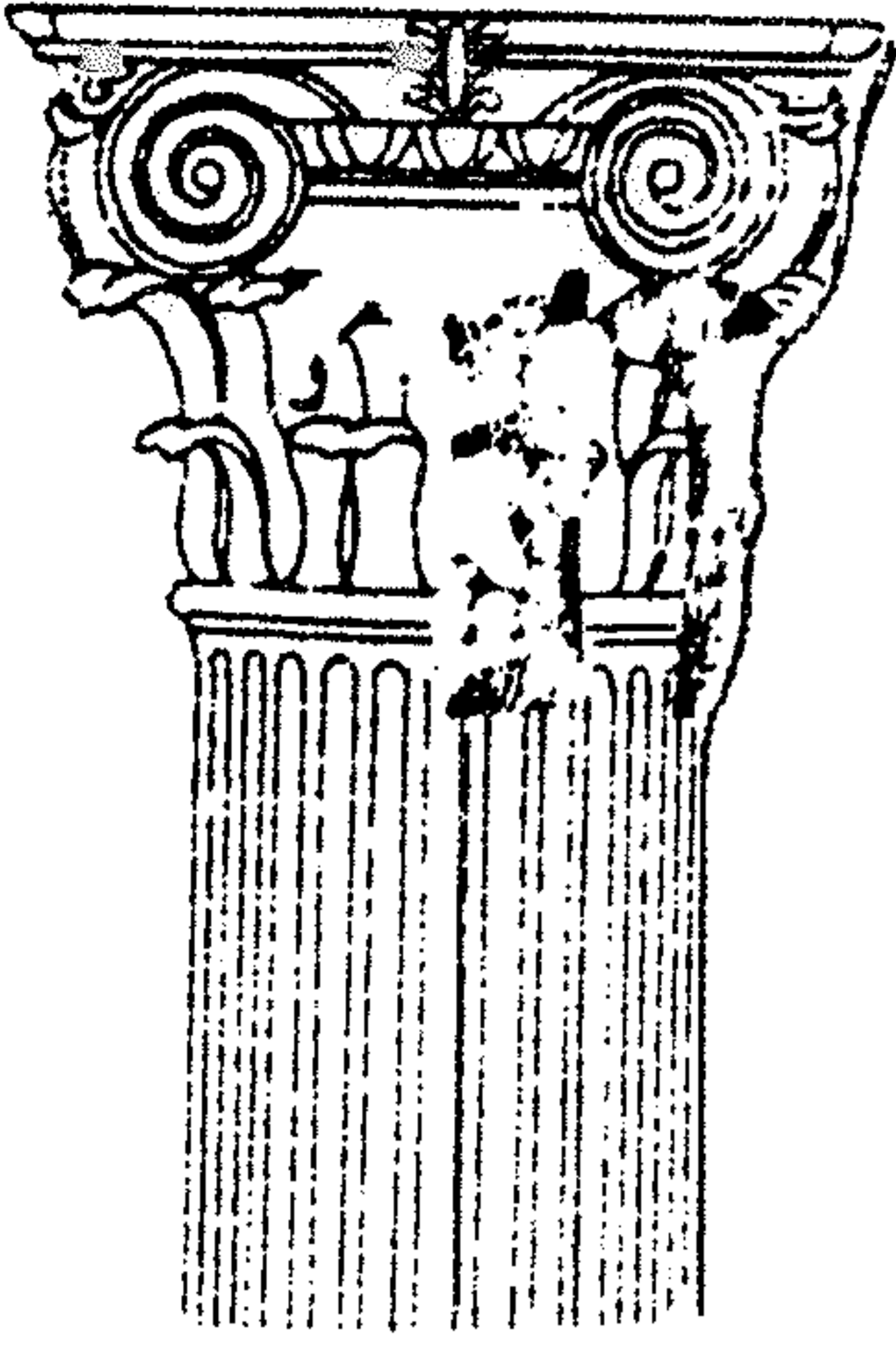
1) latest PP Post with subscription rates listed on pg. 2

DEAR MR. HAYES:

AS A LONG TIME SUPPORTER OF PRINCE NORODOM SIHANOUK (1954) WHEN HE FIRST SUBSCRIBED TO MY TROY-WORLD-COMMUNICATIONS AND INTERNATIONAL CAMPAIGNS, AND LATER DURING THE PERIOD OF 1970-1974, I DIRECTED SOME TENS OF HUNDREDS OF COMMUNICATIONS FROM HIS HIGHNESS TO THE WESTERN WORLD WHILE HE WAS IN EXILE.

LIKE MANY OTHERS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD WHO HAVE LONG AWAITED KING NORODOM SIHANOUK'S RETURN TO HIS RIGHTFUL PLACE OF LEADERSHIP IN CAMBODIA, IT WAS SOME PLEASURE TO READ ABOUT U.S. SECRETARY OF STATE WARREN CHRISTOPHER'S MEETING IN CAMBODIA.

SINCE THE INCEPTION OF THE CLINTON ADMINISTRATION, I HAVE MAINTAINED A STEADY FLOW OF DIALOGUE WITH MY FELLOW GREEK-AMERICAN AT THE WHITE HOUSE, GEORGE STEPHANOPOULOS AND MRS. HILARY CLINTON REGARDING CAMBODIA AND SIHANOUK, AND CONTINUE TO DO SO WHEN OF RELATIVE IMPORTANCE TO CAMBODIA'S WELFARE.

MR. HAYES, AS I ANTICIPATE A VISIT TO CAMBODIA THIS YEAR, I WOULD BE MOST APPRECIATIVE IF ONE OF YOUR STAFF MEMBERS COULD FORWARD ME THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION.

1. NAME OF HOTEL OR DOMICILE WHERE I CAN OBTAIN PROPER ACCOMMODATIONS FOR FIVE DAYS.
2. CONTACT WITH A GUIDE AND PRIVATE SECURITY PERSONNEL.
2. IF POSSIBLE, SEND ME SUBSCRIPTION RATES FOR YOUR NEWSPAPER.
