**Jonathan Pasternack** is a student of Maestro Peter Erös. He has appeared as guest conductor of the Aspen Music Festival Concert Orchestra, Northwest Mahler Festival, University of Washington Symphony and the Lake Union Chamber Orchestra. Mr. Pasternack has held positions including interim conductor of the Seattle Junior Youth Symphony, music director of the MIT Chamber Orchestra, and assistant conductor of the Boston Opera Lab. He has participated in the Aspen Music Festival orchestral conducting seminar and in master classes with Maestros Gerard Schwarz, David Zinman, Mury Sidlin and Yuri Tenirkonov. A classical trombonist, Mr. Pasternack has made numerous appearances as a soloist in the Northeast and Canada and is an experienced orchestral and chamber musician. Jonathan Pasternack received his bachelors of science degree from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and has studied at the Manhattan School of Music and the Mannes College of Music.
