A Workshop of Japanese Paper Craft (Origami)

2 Japanese Origami Specialists, Fumiaki Kawahata and Nobuo Aoki are coming to Cambodia to hold workshops of traditional Japanese paper craft for preschool teachers and elementary school students.

Origami is a traditional Japanese art that exemplifies Japan's outstanding aesthetic sensibility. This paper craft developed spontaneously after the introduction of paper to Japan during the reign of the Empress Suiko (6th Century). Originally used in religious ceremonies, and later as a decorative element in other rituals. Origami gradually filtered down to the masses the spread in the use of paper.
