SUBJECT: INTELLIGENCE ANALYSIS No. 0135 CONCERNING POSSIBILITIES
OF HARASSMENT AND/OR ATTACK ON CHIRILAGUA, INTIPUCA, AND
NEIGHBORING TOWNS.

1.- SITUATION/INFORMATION.

a.- Enemy situation in the General Area noted (see Annex "A" of Order of Battle)

b.- The T. [terrorists] have carried out the following activities within the area during the period between 01/21OCT983. (See Annex "B" Enemy activities)

c.- Known enemy indications within the area in question are the following:

- 1) 05OCT983: T. numbering 1500 are located in EL ESTERON J/INTIPUCA and LOMAS LAS MESAS [REDACTED] where they have a mortar of unknown caliber at the entrance of the town.
- 2) 11OCT983: An unknown number of T. are located in EL ESTERITO Beach [REDACTED] and EL CUCO [REDACTED] J/CHIRILAGUA, SAN MIGUEL, who have two 81-mm mortars with the intention of again attacking the town of INTIPUCA, LA UNION.
- 3) 19OCT983: T. who are located in the area of Cton. EL COYOLITO [REDACTED] J/EL CARMEN, are displacing in the direction of the town of CHIRILAGUA.
- 4) 19OCT983: T. who are located in the area of the EL ICACAL Beach [REDACTED] J/INTIPUCA, have displaced to CHIRILAGUA.
- 5) 21OCT983: T. are awaiting munitions via the maritime route on the beaches at EL CUCO [REDACTED] and EL MAJAGUE [REDACTED] J/ CHIRILAGUA, as well as having control of the highway to EL CUCO from Crio. ZAPATAGUA [REDACTED]

2.- POSSIBILITIES.

a.- T. plan to attack and/or take over, from today on, with an undetermined number of troops, the following locations:

- 1) CHIRILAGUA J/SAN MIGUEL
- 2) INTIPUCA J/SAN MIGUEL
- 3) Other towns near those mentioned above.

b.- The continuous movements, as well as the locations detected within the area, have possibly been carried out with the goal of the T. to supply themselves logistically in the area in question.

3.- CONCLUSIONS.

- a.- The T. locations, as well as the movements made by the enemy, especially toward CHIRILAGUA, indicate that the T. plan to carry out future activities in the towns in question.
- b.- In order to reach its goals, the T. can supply themselves logistically in weapons and munitions, since experience indicates that the area in question is high in supplies.
- c.- The T. in the area of CHIRILAGUA J/SAN MIGUEL and in INTIPUCA J/LA UNION, in order to reach their goal are reinforcing themselves with T. from the general area of JUCUARAN, as as with T. located in the area SOUTH of USULUTAN.
- d.- T. in the area plan to carry out actions on a large scale with the goal of keeping the area free and thus keeping the supplies, which are coming from outside, free.

4.- RECOMMENDATIONS.

- a.- That D-III plan an immediate military action in the area in question with any Immediate Reaction Battalion, in order to counter and/or neutralize any attempt to attack the towns in question; as well as also not allowing the enemy to receive supplies.
- b.- To alert the units located in the towns mentioned, in order that they not be surprised by the enemy.

2.- DISPOSITION
a.- LOCATION OF CAMPS

- 1) An undetermined number of T. are located along the beach at EL CUCO [redacted] up to the EL MAJAGUE Beach [redacted] J/CHIRILAGUA, SAN MIGUEL. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 2) An undetermined number of T. are located in LOMA EL PORTILLO [redacted] LOMA MONTERICO [redacted] J/CHIRILAGUA, who have 81-mm mortars, 50-mm machine guns emplaced. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 3) An undetermined number of T. are located on the roads which lead from EL CRIO. EL JOBO [redacted] to PUNTA LA VENTANA Beach [redacted] where they have mortars and machine guns emplaced. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 4) T. are located in EL ESTERO [redacted] LOMA LAS MESAS [redacted] J/CHIRILAGUA. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 5) An undetermined number of T. are located in EL ESTERON [redacted] J/INTIPUCA. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 6) An undetermined number of T. have control of ISLA EL ARCO [redacted] and have contingent positions in LA RINGLERA [redacted] and LOMA EL CALAVOZO [redacted] J/JUCUARAN. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 7) An undetermined number of T. are located in CRIO ZAPATAGUA [redacted] and HUALOSO [redacted] J/CHIRILAGUA. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 8) T. located in CHIRILAGUA are giving Military training to groups of children ages 10 to 14 in the public square.

b.- MOVEMENTS

- 1) 07OCT983. T. numbering approximately 200 are mobilizing from CHIRILAGUA toward the Beach at EL CARRIZAL [redacted] where they are continually arriving at CTON EL CUCO [redacted] J/CHIRILAGUA. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 2) 11OCT983. T. located in the coastal area of the town of CHIRILAGUA are turning back as needed through the Beach at EL ESTERITO [redacted] and EL CUCO [redacted] of the same Jurisdiction, who are awaiting supplies of weapons which are to arrive in the coastal area, and they have a .30 machine gun and a mortar of unknown caliber in place. - 1 The T. in the general area of CHIRILAGUA have been supplied with all types of foodstuffs, cash from robberies in various locations and in the following ways:
2. 083001AG0983 T. established a point of attack at the TURNOFF TO CTON ZAPATAGUA [redacted] J/CHIRILAGUA, SAN MIGUEL, stealing money and personal effects from the passengers and drivers of vehicles.
3. 140026AG0983 T. stole cattle from the HDA. CHILANGUERA J/CHIRILAGUA, SAN MIGUEL.
4. 230005SEP983 T. ransacked several business establishments in CTON and CRIO EL CUCO [redacted] J/CHIRILAGUA, SAN MIGUEL from which they stole foodstuffs, cash, 2 38-caliber Special revolvers, 1 tape recorder, flashlights, RAYO-VAC batteries, clothing, and shoes.
5. 123006SEP983 T. stole the sum of \$500.00 colones in cash, 1 22-mm caliber pistol from a house located in CTON AND CRIO EL CUCO [redacted] J/CHIRILAGUA, SAN MIGUEL.
6. 134014SEP983 T. assaulted Messrs. RIGOBERTO DIAZ AND MAURICIO WALTER FLORES, employees of the Union Bank for Farming and Animal Husbandry in the place called LA MARANONERA [redacted] J/CHIRILAGUA, SAN MIGUEL).
7. 25SEP983 T. who took over the VILLA DE CHIRILAGUA penetrated the LOCAL HEADQUARTERS from which they stole olive green uniforms of the DC [Civil Defense], in an unspecified quantity.

- 2.- 214517OCT983 They carried out harassment fire on the town of INTIPUCA, LA UNION, with no casualties reported.
- 3.- 153010OCT983 T. set fire to a vehicle, license plates not identified, of the Ministry of Health, in Crio. ZAPATAGUA J/CHIRILAGUA, SAN MIGUEL.
- 4.- 153010OCT983 T. seriously wounded the common-law wife of Mr. MIGUEL PARADA, in Crio. ZAPATAGUA J/CHIRILAGUA, SAN MIGUEL.
