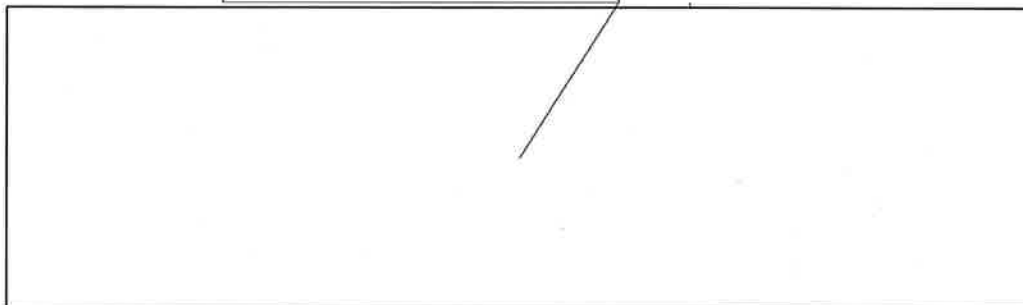

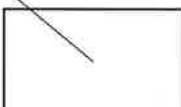

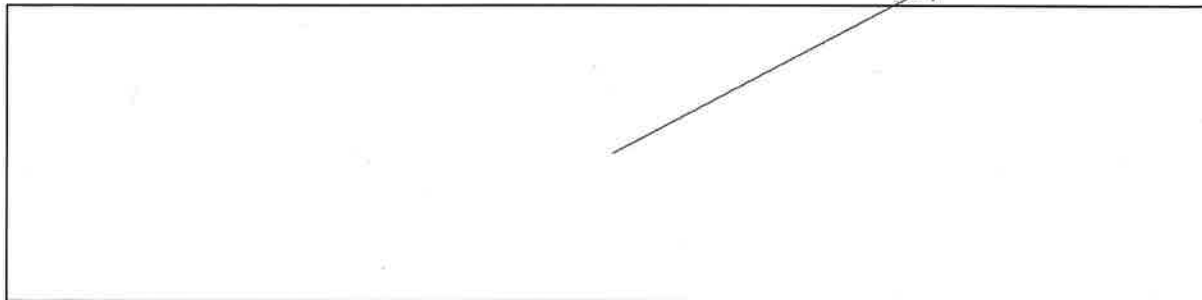

3. (U) THE SWEEP REPORTEDLY NETTED TWO INSURGENT BASE CAMPS AND A HOSPITAL. THE GOVERNMENT ALSO RELEASED UNCONFIRMED CASUALTY FIGURES OF 26 GOVERNMENT AND 200 INSURGENT DEAD.

4. ~~(C/NF)~~ THE MORAŽAN-SAN MIGUEL OPERATION ENDED ON 28 DECEMBER WITH THE KICKOFF OF A MAJOR OPERATION IN WESTERN USULUTAN INVOLVING THREE US-TRAINED IMMEDIATE-REACTION BATTALIONS, TWO CAZADOR BATTALIONS, AND A CAVALRY SQUADRON.

5. ~~(C/NF)~~ MEANWHILE, OPERATION SALITRE VI, WHICH INVOLVES A THREE-BATTALION FORCE, BEGAN ON THE 28TH NEAR GUAZAPA VOLCANO IN CENTRAL EL SALVADOR. AN OPERATION WITH TWO CAZADOR BATTALIONS WAS ALSO UNDERWAY ON THE SAME DATE IN SAN VICENTE DEPARTMENT, SOUTH OF TECOLUCA [Redacted].
