Dear Marje:

Concerning your fax of Oct. 18, the copies of your book have not arrived yet. Did you mail them to our office address here in Cambodia or to our mail address in Thailand (listed below)? No problem using the poem with citation from Post.

I can't answer you with any certainty on whether or not mail order would work for sending books to Cambodia. We still use our address in Bangkok for most correspondence, especially on subscriptions with checks, because it's reliable and we go to Bangkok every two weeks so there is no problem with picking up the mail. Many people use the mail services here and say that it is quite reliable. I've even had letters from overseas delivered by the Post Office to our door here in Phnom Penh with cash in them. So, I guess its a toss up.

As far as your ad, I still think it would be useful as we have 700 subscribers in over 40 countries who receive the Post regularly and many of these are former UNTAC people who have now gone on to other postings.

Our rates are U.S. \$21 per column inch (our non-profit rate). 150 mm would be just over 6 inches, so for a total of 12 col inches we would charge you \$252 per insertion.

If you want to book an ad, fax us the text and send us a check to Bangkok address listed below made out to "Phnom Penh Post Publishing". Also, please specify which issue(s) you want to run it in (by calculating publishing dates - every two weeks on Friday - from a back issue you have already).
