"Cambodian NGO Leaders to Meet to Discuss the Role of NGOs in the Coming Elections"

On Tuesday, December 12th and Wednesday, December 13th Cambodian NGO leaders will gather at the Cambodian Hotel in Phnom Penh for a seminar entitled "Election Monitoring, Voter Education and the Role of Cambodian NGOs in the Election Process."

The seminar, which is being sponsored by the National Democratic Institute for International Affairs (NDI) will feature presentations by leaders of successful election monitoring and voter education organizations in other Asian nations. Participants will discuss how NGOs can help to educate Cambodian voters and ensure that the coming election in Cambodia are free and fair. Senior officials from NAMFREL in the Philippines, the Movement for Free and Fair Elections (MFFE) in Sri Lanka and PollWatch in Thailand are scheduled to speak during the two-day seminar.
