Japanese ODA News Exchange of Notes For Japan's ODA Loan

In response to the request from the Royal Government of Cambodia and with a view to promoting economic stability and development of the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Government of Japan has decided to extend to the Royal Government of Cambodia a concessional loan in Japanese yen up to the amount of **one billion yen (¥1,000,000,000)**, or equivalent of **8,695,000 US dollars**. The loan will be extended by the Japan Bank for International Cooperation (JBIC), an implementation agency of ODA loans of the Government of Japan, to support the **Poverty Reduction and Growth Operation (PRGO)**.

The Notes to this effect will be exchanged between **H.E. Mr. HOR Namhong**, Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation and **H.E. Mr. Katsuhiko SHINOHARA**, Ambassador of Japan to the Kingdom of Cambodia on October 09, 2007 at 11:00 a.m. at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation.
