Exchange of Notes for Japan's Grant Aid

January 18, 2005 at 9:00 a.m.

at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation

In response to the request from the Royal Government of Cambodia and with a view to further promoting the economic stabilization and development efforts of the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Government of Japan has decided to extend grant aid up to the amount of **five hundred and ten million yen (¥ 510,000,000)** approximately equivalent to **four million six hundred and thirty-six thousand US Dollars (US\$ 4,636,000)**, to the Royal Government of Cambodia for the purpose of contributing to the implementation of the two following projects:

1. ¥ 466,000,000 for the execution of Peace Building and Comprehensive Small Arms Management Program in Cambodia (Phase II), and
2. ¥ 44,000,000 for the services necessary for the detailed design for the execution of the project for the Rehabilitation of the Kandal Stung Irrigation System.

The Notes to these effects will be exchanged on January 18, 2005 at 9:00 a.m. at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation between **H.E. Mr. HOR NAMHONG**, Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation and **H.E. Mr. TAKAHASHI FUMIAKI**, Ambassador of Japan to the Kingdom of Cambodia.
