

The @6. 38 from Basreh We are taking & getting deep, I sent a telegram to my father today, Wishing him and all the family & friends a happy new Year, Good many passengers came off many Bahrein people going to pilgrimage, I worked in giving tickets till late in the evening, We are drawing 4 feet fore & aft, --- At 6 P. M. the Dijleh left Basreh for Maghil, the "Amberwitch" is lying here, Mr. & Mrs. Walton & family are not going with us they are to remain here & go up in the "London" --- Came to off Maghil, Capt Holland went to dine with Carter, I went on shore after diner to see Yousef, he is in bed & had the fever since yesterday --- Capt Holland has persuaded Mr. Walton and family to go with us, and they are going up, the Dijleh will be detained till tomorrow 10 AM, We will loose a full days run and Blockey wanted us to leave Basreh before the beginning of the new year; --- it is awfully disappointing & disgusting to see such a change of ideas and loss of time & expence of coal; We passed our New Year's eve very quietly on board opposite Maghil, I turned in at 10 P. M; .
