DAVIS, MILES (Dewey, III) [Prince of Darkness] born 25 May 1926, Alton, IL. Trumpeter and Bandleader. An original, lyrical soloist and a demanding group leader, he was the most consistently innovative musician in jazz from the late 1940's through the 1960's.

GROVES DICTIONARY

Most of the music on the concert is from Miles Davis' early jazz-rock period, specifically the BITCHES BREW and IN A SILENT WAY albums. This music is rarely performed even though it has been influential in shaping and revolutionizing jazz. Check out Ralph J. Gleason's original liner notes: "...listen to this. This music will change the world like the cool and walkin' did and now that communication is faster and more complete it may change it more deeply and more quickly...music is the greatest of the arts for me because it cuts through everything, needs no aids. It is. It simply is. And in contemporary music, Miles defines the terms. That's all. It's his turf."
