On page 3 of your newspaper (24.3.-5.4. 2007) in the story "10 years after the grenade
attack" the following is written:

"Some victims were taken to the nearby Kantha Bopha II Children's Hospital but
Dr. Beat Richner, the hospital's director, refused them entry. They were left on the
footpath".

This is a lye. A slander. An intentional slander, because you are informed about the
truth: I was at this time in a pagoda (Wat Bakheng) giving a concert not being aware
of what has happened.

It is further an intentional criminal damage of the reputation of the institution Kantha
Bopha saving thousands of lives of Cambodian Children year by year. These
Children's lives depend on donations. These donations are given as long the
institution's reputation is good. (26 Million USD per year).
