Germany continues to support flood victims

On Wednesday, 29 November 2000, the German Ambassador to Cambodia, **Harald Loeschner**, will distribute aid packages to flood victims in Kandal and Svay Rieng provinces. The humanitarian assistance worth some

225.000,- German Marks

is funded by the German Government and will be used to provide **23.400 people** especially with food and reconstruction material for their houses. The project will be implemented by the Adventist Development and Relief Agency - ADRA - in Cambodia.

This new donation is in addition to the aid package of about

18 million German Marks

for emergency flood relief and for the reconstruction of damaged infrastructure - committed by the German Minister for Economic Development and Cooperation, H.E. Mrs. Heidemarie Wieczorek-Zeul, during her recent visit from 7 to 9 October 2000 in Cambodia.
