Background:

- 1) Do you consider yourself disabled? If not, how would you describe yourself?
- 2) What are some things that are different for you because of your disability** that a non-disabled person might not expect?
- 3) How long have you been disabled**?
- 4) Do you think your disability** has changed you as a person in any way?
- 5) Is there anything about your life as a disabled** student that you struggle explaining to people?

Accommodations:

- 1) Did you receive any accommodations during college? What were they?
- 2) Which accommodations were most helpful to you?
- 3) Did you face any challenges with the process of receiving accommodations?

Success:

- 1) What are you studying/did you study in college?
- 2) How did you choose this subject?
- 3) What are your plans for the future?
- 4) What are a few things you are proud of having done in college or since? (examples: a research project, a leadership position, taking a difficult class, making friends, getting a job or internship, an art project, etc.)
- 5) What is one accomplishment you can brag about?

- 6) Is there anything that we haven't talked about yet that you think is important to share?
