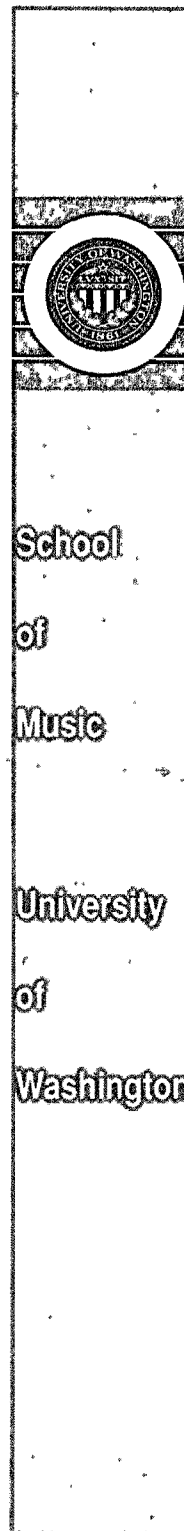

ASHLEY CRAGUN is a sophomore pursuing a Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Music degree. She studies with Rebecca Henderson. Originally from Port Angeles, she continues to play with the Port Angeles Symphony and Turtle Bluff Chamber Orchestras. Ms. Cragun has also competed and won the North Olympic Concerto and Turtle Bluff Concerto competitions.

BRAD FITCH is a junior pursuing a Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Music degree. He studies with Michael Brockman.

JEFFREY WANG began studying cello with Eugene Schweiger when he was twelve. He has studied with Raymond Davis, David Tonkonogui and Rajan Krishnaswami and currently studies with Toby Saks. He is performing on a cello made in Seattle by Erich Schweiger in 1995. After attaining his undergraduate degree, Mr. Wang hopes to continue studying at The Curtis Institute and The Juilliard School of Music.

A native of Taiwan, pianist YU-TING CHEN is studying for a doctoral degree with Craig Sheppard. She received her Bachelor's and Master's degrees at the San Francisco Conservatory of Music studying with Mack McCray. She has won concerto competitions and performed as a soloist with the orchestra at Taipei Municipal Teachers College. In the past seven years Ms. Chen has performed nine different recital programs; the most recent of which was an all-Brahms program. As a collaborative artist she has performed chamber music concerts in Seattle as an active member of the Young Internationals Chamber Music Society. She is currently a piano accompanist for two Chinese choirs and numerous instrumentalists.
