SUBJECT: Analysis of Intelligence No. 0135 about the possibilities of harassment and/or attack to CHIRILAGUA, INTIPUCA and adjoining towns.

1.-Situation-Information

a.-The enemy situation in the general area mentioned (see Annex "A" of the Battle Order).

b.-The terrorists have carried out the following activities in the area during the time between 1st and 21st of October 1983. (see Annex "B" activities of the enemy)

c.-The known indications of the enemy in the above mentioned area are the following:

1) October 5, 1983; terrorists in number of 1500 are located in EL ESTERON INTIPUCA Jurisdiction and LOMAS LAS MESAS, in which they have set up an undetermined caliber mortar at the entrance of the town.

2) October 11, 1983; terrorists in undetermined numbers are located in the EL ESTERITO Beach and EL CUCO CHIRILAGUA Jurisdiction, SAN MIGUEL, in which they have two 81 mm mortars with the intension of attacking again the town of INTIPUCA, LA UNION.

3) October 19, 1983; terrorists that were located in the zone of the Canton EL COYOLITO EL CARMEN Jurisdiction, are being mobilized in the direction of CHIRILAGUA town.

4) October 19, 1983; terrorists that were located in the zone of the EL ICACAL Beach INTIPUCA Jurisdiction, have been mobilized toward CHIRILAGUA.

5) October 21, 1983; terrorists are awaiting ammunitions by sea in the beaches of EL CUCO and EL MAJAGUE CHIRILAGUA Jurisdiction, the same way they have control of the EL CUCO Highway from the Hamlet ZAPATAGUA

2.-Possibilities

a.-Terrorists expect to attack and/or to take from this date with an undetermined number of effectives the following places:

1) CHIRILAGUA SAN MIGUEL Jurisdiction

2) INTIPUCA LA UNION Jurisdiction

3) Other adjoining towns to the above mention [1,2]

- b.-The continuous movement, as well as the detected locations in the zone possibly have been to achieve the end that the terrorists intend to logistically supply themselves in the mentioned area.

3.-Conclusions

- a.-The terrorists locations as well as the movements carried out by the enemy, especially towards CHIRILAGUA, indicates that the terrorists intend to carry out future activities in the above mentioned towns.
- b.-To carry out their objectives the terrorists can logistically supply themselves with arms and ammunitions, since the experience indicates that the mentioned area is of supply principally.
- c.-The terrorists of the CHIRILAGUA, SAN MIGUEL Jurisdiction area, and that of INTIPUCA, LA UNION Jurisdiction, to obtain their purposes they reinforce with terrorists of the general area from JUCUARAN, as well as the terrorists also located in the area south of USULUTAN.
- d.-Terrorists of the area intend to carry out actions in a great scale with the objective to maintain the zone free and therefore to have free access to the supplies that come from the exterior.

4.-Recommendations

- a.-That the D-III plan an immediate military action in the area mentioned above, with any of the Immediate Reaction Battalion, with the objective of counter arrests and/or neutralize any intent of attack to the mentioned towns; as well as to not permit the enemy to receive supplies.
- b.-To alert the units located in the mentioned towns, in order that they will not be surprised by the enemy.

2. Disposition

a. Encampment Location

- 1) Terrorists in undetermined number are located along the EL CUCO Beach towards the EL MAJAGUE Beach (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c) CHIRILAGUA Jurisdiction, SAN MIGUEL, (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 2) Terrorists in undetermined number are located in EL PORTILLO Field MONTERICO Hill (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c) CHIRILAGUA Jurisdiction, and have set up 81 mm mortars, 50 mm machine guns. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 3) Terrorists in undetermined number are located on the streets of the Hamlet EL JOBO (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c) to the PUNTA LA VENTANA Beach (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c) in which they have set up mortars and machine guns. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 4) Terrorists are located in the ESTERO LAS MESAS Hill (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c) CHIRILAGUA Jurisdiction. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 5) Terrorists in undetermined number are located in the ESTERON INTIPUCA Jurisdiction. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 6) Terrorists in undetermined number are controlling the EL ARCO Island who have eventual positions in the RINGLERA and EL CALAVOZO Hill (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c) JUCUARAN Jurisdiction. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 7) Terrorists in undetermined number are located in the Hamlet ZAPATAGUA and HUALOSO (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c) CHIRILAGUA Jurisdiction. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 8) Terrorists that are located in CHIRILAGUA, gave military instructions to groups of children from 10 to 14 years of age in the public plaza.

b. Movements

- 1) October 7, 1983, approximately 200 terrorists, are mobilizing from CHIRILAGUA towards the CARRIZAL Beach (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c) where they are arriving constantly to the Hamlet EL CUCO (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c) CHIRILAGUA Jurisdiction. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)
- 2) October 11, 1983, terrorists that are located in the coastal zone of the town of CHIRILAGUA eventually go to the ESTERITO Beach (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c) and EL CUCO (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c) of the same Jurisdiction, who are waiting for the supplies of arms that will arrive by the coastal zone and where they have set up a .30 machine gun and a undetermined caliber mortar. - 3) October 19, 1983, terrorists that are located in the Hamlet EL COYOLITO EL CARMEN Jurisdiction, are being mobilized towards the zone of the CHIRILAGUA town. (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c)

- 1.- 10OCT83 Terrorists distributed subversive propaganda in Canton and Hamlet EL CARAO (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(h); Sec. INTIPUCA Jurisdiction, LA UNION, with a title that says: "The FMLN. alerts the settlers of this zone".
- 2.-214517OCT83 They carried out harassing, firing in the town of INTIPUCA, LA UNION, without reported casualties.
- 3.-153010OCT83 Terrorists burned a vehicle with an identified plate, property of the Health Department, around the Hamlet of ZAPATAGUA (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c) CHIRILAGUA Jurisdiction, SAN MIGUEL.
- 4.-153010OCT83 Terrorists hurt very badly the wife of Mr. MIGUEL PARADA, around the Hamlet of ZAPATAGUA (b)(1); Sec. 1.4(b); Sec. 1.4(c) CHIRILAGUA Jurisdiction, SAN MIGUEL.
