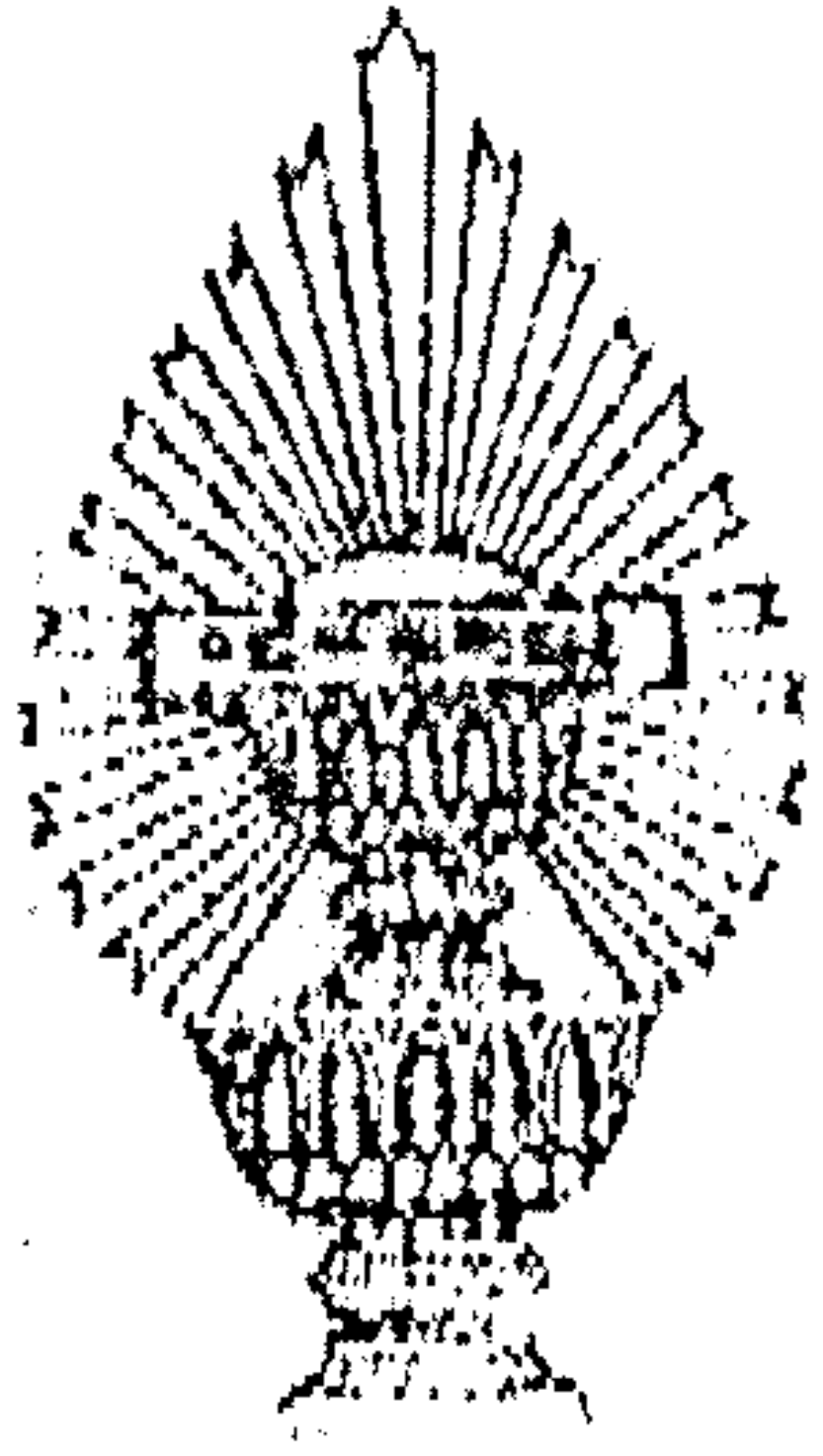

## INVITATION TO A CRUISE ON 31 DECEMBER

On Sunday, 31 December 2000, a group of members of parliament, including Sam Rainsy, will visit a series of villages in Kandal and Kompong Chhnang provinces, along the western bank of the Tonle Sap River. They will deliver irrigation systems to villagers in the area and will negotiate the purchase of fishing rights from fishing lot owners in order to give back those fishing rights to the villagers.

Several hundreds of families of farmers and fishermen will welcome the members of parliament who will go on a cruise starting from a village nearby the old capital city of Oudong (about one-hour drive from Phnom Penh). The scenery there is beautiful. Lunch will be served during the cruise and participants can also fish with the villagers at the same time.

All interested persons, including diplomats, journalists and NGO workers, are warmly invited to join the party. A convoy will leave the National Assembly at 9.00 am and will be back in Phnom Penh at around 3.00 pm on the same day.
