**Conference of
German-Cambodian Association
in Phnom Penh
to Strengthen Bilateral Relationship**

A conference of former Cambodian students in Germany - jointly organised by the German Embassy, the German-Cambodian Association and the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) - will take place from November 23 to November 24, 1998, in Phnom Penh. The German-Cambodian Association unites more than 250 Cambodians who studied at German universities or were trained in German enterprises.
