**Sector Related Programme Health II**

On 30th October 1995 Mr. Stephan Kinnemann, Senior Vice- President for the region Asia and Pacific of the Kreditanstalt für Wiederaufbau (KfW) of the Federal Republic of Germany and the Royal Cambodian Government represented by H.E. Mr. Chhay Than, Undersecretary of State of the Ministry of Economy and Finance, signed a financing agreement on the Sector Related Programme Health II.

With the Health Programme II, the KfW will continue the very successful Health Programme I, which started in 1993/1994 and provided drugs worth 8,2 Mio DM. The new drug delivery is due to arrive in the next few months and it amounts to an equivalent of 5.0 Mio DM.

The aim of the two Health Programmes is the fight against widespread diseases like malaria and tuberculosis. They are an important contribution to Cambodia's National Malaria Programme and an important component of the German-Cambodian economic cooperation in the health sector.

The signing of the agreement for this new programme and its implementation are the results of the close German-Cambodian cooperation which will even be strengthened by the forthcoming official visit of H.E. Dr. Klaus Kinkel, Minister of Foreign Affairs and Vice Chancellor of Germany from the 2nd to the 4th of November.
