Handing-Over Ceremony of Japanese Emergency Assistance for Flood Victims in the Kingdom of Cambodia

The Handing-Over Ceremony of Japanese Emergency Assistance for Flood Victims will be held on Monday, September 18, 2000 at 3p.m. at the National Committee on Disaster Management Secretariat (NCDM) between H.E. Mr. PEQU Samy, Secretary General of the NCDM and Mr. Eiji YAMAMOTO, Chargé d'Affaires a. i. of the Embassy of Japan to the Kingdom of Cambodia.

The Government of Japan has decided to provide emergency relief materials worth of approximately US\$ 187,000 and emergency grant aid (in cash) of US\$ 100,000, taking into account the scale of the flood as well as the friendly relationship between the two countries.

In this Handing-Over Ceremony, emergency relief materials listed below will be handed over to the NCDM:

1. 75 sets of tents for 6 persons
2. 2,200 blankets
3. 338 rolls of plastic sheets.

The Embassy of Japan expects that these aids will contribute to help the Royal Government of Cambodia in its efforts to alleviate the suffering of the people affected by the recent inundation.
