SANTA ANA: NO CHANGE. A HIGH GUERRILLA PRESENCE REMAINS IN THE DEPARTMENT. HIGH LEVEL GUERRILLA ACTIVITY WAS NOTED ON THE HIGHWAY OUT OF THE CITY OF SANTA ANA TO METAPAN. THE GUERRILLAS HAVE TARGETED THE HIGHWAYS FROM SANTA ANA TO SAN SALVADOR; SANTA ANA TO SONSONATE; SANTA ANA TO AHUACHAPAN; AHUACHAPAN TO SONSONATE; AND AHUACHAPAN TO JUAYUA, FOR AMBUSH, ROBBERY, AND TROOP HARASSMENT ACTIVITY [redacted] (b)(1)

ONE HUNDRED GUERRILLAS WERE ALSO NOTED MOVING TOWARDS CERRO ANONA ON THE GUATEMALA-SALVADOR BORDER.

CHALATENANGO: SIX FPL UNITS WERE NOTED OPERATING IN HONDURAN TERRITORY FOR THIS REPORTING PERIOD. TWO OF THE FPL LOCATIONS ARE VERY NEAR PREVIOUSLY REPORTED RESUPPLY STOPOVER POINTS. DURING THE LAST REPORTING PERIOD 600 GUERRILLAS WERE NOTED GATHERING IN THE LAS VUELTAS AREA. IT IS NOT KNOWN AT THIS TIME IF THIS ACTIVITY IS RELATED TO RESUPPLY. DELIVERIES, TWO PROBABLE HELICOPTER DELIVERIES, AND TWO  
POSSIBLE OVERLAND DELIVERIES. U/I AIR SIGHTINGS REMAIN SUBJECT  
TO QUESTION. THE HELO AND SEA DELIVERIES, WHEN COUPLED WITH  
ACTIVITY IN NICARAGUA, SEEM TO FALL THREE TO FOUR DAYS AFTER  
THE BB 318 AEROCARIBE NON-SCHEDULED FLIGHT LANDS AT SANDINO AND  
POSSIBLY GOES ON TO LOS BRAZILLES. OVERLAND DELIVERY SEEMS TO  
TAKE 40 DAYS AFTER RECEIPT IN NICARAGUA. THE BREAKDOWN OF  
PROCEDURE REGARDING OVERLAND DELIVERY REMAINS UNCLEAR AT THIS

A BB 318 AEROCARIBE FLIGHT IS EXPECTED ON THE 7TH OF NOVEMBER WITH 612 BOXES OF CHICKENS AND 80 BOXES OF EGGS. THE CUBAN FLAG VESSEL "JOSE MARTI" WILL CARRY OUT THE DELIVERY BEFORE THE END OF THE YEAR, AND THE SHIPMENT WILL CARRY FIVE UNMARKED CONTAINERS OF BUTTONS [ ]

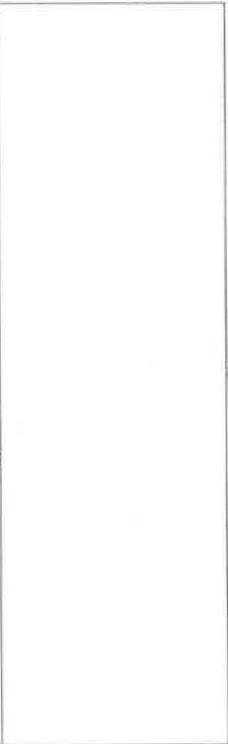
