Ernest Henley received his doctorate in physics in 1952 from the University of California, Berkeley. He came to the University of Washington in 1954 and was named professor of physics in 1961, serving as chairman of the Department of Physics from 1973 to 1976. He was appointed Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences in 1979. Not so well known is that he studied piano privately in the not-so-distant past.
