The Government of Japan has decided to provide a total amount of **US\$1,085,588** to **4** projects, detailed further below, through its Grant Assistance for Grassroots/Human Security Projects (KUSANONE or Grassroots Grant) and Grant Assistance for Japanese NGO's Projects.

1. **US\$831,794 for the Project for Supporting Humanitarian Mineclearance in Northwest Border Districts**

2. **US\$89,752 for the Project for Construction of National Eye Center at Preah Ang Duong Hospital**  
Recipient: *Preah Ang Duong Hospital*
3. **US\$81,472 for the Project for Road Safety Curriculum Implementation in 20 Provinces and 3 Municipalities**  
Recipient: *Handicap International Belgium*
4. **US\$82,570 for the Project for Construction School Buildings at Phan Nheum Primary School and Treng Primary School**  
Recipient: *Shanti Volunteer Association (SVA)*
