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SUBJECT: SOIC BRIEFING PAPER

1. FOLLOWING IS BRIEFING PAPER FOR PERIOD 5-10 OCT 84.
THIS PAPER IS FOR (b)(1)
(b)(3) NatSecAct INTERNAL USE ONLY.

GUERRILLA ACTIVITY DECREASED SIGNIFICANTLY AFTER THREE WEEKS OF HIGH LEVEL ACTIVITY. ACTIVITY REMAINED HIGH ONLY IN THE SAN VICENTE AND USULUTAN DEPARTMENTS. ACTIVITY IN CUSCATLAN, SAN SALVADOR, MORAZAN, AND NORTHERN LA UNION DEPARTMENTS DROPPED. ACTIVITY IN EASTERN CHALATENANGO DEPARTMENT WAS DUE TO GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS IN THE AREA.

NEW ACTIVITY EMERGED IN THE FORM OF PROPAGANDA ACTION IN THE NORTHERN PORTION OF SANTA ANA DEPARTMENT, AND WITH THE MOVEMENT OF GUERRILLAS BACK INTO THE CERRO SAN PEDRO CAMP SYSTEM.

PRIMARY AND SECONDARY GUERRILLA TARGETS, HOWEVER, REMAIN THE SAME AS FOR THE LAST THREE REPORTING PERIODS WITH NO NEW ADDITIONAL TARGETS.

RESUPPLY ACTIVITY, THAT RESUMED WITH THE QUARTER MOON ON THE FIRST OF OCTOBER, CONTINUED ALONG THE SALVADORAN COAST FROM THE LEMPA RIVER TO THE GULF OF FONSECA. SEA DELIVERY WAS EXPECTED BETWEEN THE 6-10 OCTOBER TIME FRAME. AIR ACTIVITY WAS NOTED FROM THE 2ND OF OCTOBER IN SANTA ANA DEPARTMENT, LA PAZ DEPARTMENT AND USULUTAN DEPARTMENT.

ANALYST COMMENT: FOUR SIGNIFICANT CHANGES HAVE EMERGED OVER THE LAST EIGHT REPORTING PERIODS AND FIVE OVER THE LAST YEAR.

DURING THE LAST YEAR FIVE CHANGES WITHIN THE SALVADORAN MILITARY AND ONE IN THE POLITICAL SPHERE HAVE LED TO THE PRESENT GOVERNMENT ADVANTAGE. WHETHER THIS ADVANTAGE WILL CONTINUE, I AM NOT SURE. THE FIVE MILITARY CHANGES HAVE ALLOWED THE SALVADORAN MILITARY TO CONDUCT A MORE COHESIVE, LOGICAL, AND SUCCESSFUL MILITARY CAMPAIGN.

WITH THE APPOINTMENT OF COL. BLANDON AS CHIEF OF STAFF, MILITARY RESPONSE TO THE GUERRILLA PROBLEM HAS TURNED FROM KNEE JERK REACTION TO ONE OF GOOD USE OF INTELLIGENCE DATA TO RUN GOVERNMENT SWEEP OPERATIONS IN THE PROPER AREAS, TO RESPOND TO

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GUERRILLA ATTACKS WITH THE PROPER NUMBER AND TYPE OF TROOPS, TO MAINTAIN, TRAIN, AND EQUIP THE MILITARY FORCES, TO RAISE MORALE, AND KEEP HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATIONS TO A MINIMUM. THE OTHER CHANGES THAT OCCURRED IN THE MILITARY WERE: CONTINUOUS GOVERNMENT SWEEP OPERATIONS WITH ONLY ONE TO TWO WEEKS DOWN FOR TROOPS. THIS HAS REDUCED TROOP TIME IN GARRISONS, AND GIVEN THE TROOPS VALUABLE FIELD EXPERIENCE. TWO, USE OF THE PRAALS HAS NOT ONLY PRODUCED GOOD INTELLIGENCE INFORMATION BUT HAS CONFUSED THE GUERRILLAS AS TO THE [] AREA OF OPERATIONS, CAPABILITIES, AND NUMBER. THE PRAALS ALSO SEEM NOT TO BE PENETRATED. THREE, DNI INFORMATION, WITH THE ACQUISITION OF A COMPUTER, HAS TRIPLED THE NUMBER OF INTELLIGENCE DATA REPORTS TO THE ESTADO MAYOR AND THIS AGENCY. THIS INFORMATION HAS BEEN ACTED UPON. FOUR, THE NAVY HAS FINALLY JOINED THE WAR EFFORT, ALBEIT IN LIMITED FASHION, PROVIDING SOME CAPABILITY ON THE PART OF THE GOVERNMENT TO RUN ACTIONS IN THE JUCARAN TRIANGLE AREA. THE POLITICAL CHANGE THAT OCCURRED WAS THAT DUARTE GAINED INTERNATIONAL LEGITIMACY AND RECOGNITION.

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OVER THE LAST EIGHT WEEKS THE CHANGE OF COMMANDERS IN CHALATENANGO DEPARTMENT HAS DECIDEDLY BEEN FOR THE BETTER. GUERRILLAS IN THE CHALATENANGO AREA HAVE RESPONDED THE SAME WAY THE GUERRILLAS DID IN MORAZAN AND NORTHERN SAN MIGUEL WITH THE APPOINTMENT OF MONTERROSA. WE HAVE SEEN, IN ALL THE REPORTING SOURCES, A DECIDED DROP IN MORALE LEADING TO NUMEROUS DESERTIONS, DISRUPTED RESUPPLY CORRIDORS, AND A MOVEMENT ON THE PART OF THE GUERRILLAS TO SANCTUARIES AWAY FROM HARD TARGETS TO AVOID CONFRONTATION WITH THE GOVERNMENT TROOPS. THIS MOVEMENT HAS BEEN TO CONTESTED AREAS OF THE HONDURAN/SALVADORAN BORDER WHERE THE GUERRILLAS FEEL THEY WILL BE INACCESSIBLE TO GOVERNMENT TROOPS. THIS DISRUPTION OF GUERRILLA ACTIVITY HAS OCCURRED WHERE EFFECTIVE COMMANDERS ARE USING GOOD INTELLIGENCE DATA AND RUNNING CONTINUOUS SWEEP OPERATIONS IN THE RIGHT AREAS. THIS, IN TURN, HAS LED TO A GUERRILLA RETURN TO TERRORIST ACTIONS IN SMALL NUMBERS BELOW BATTALION STRENGTH AND LOW LEVEL ACTIVITY FOR NINE OUT OF TWELVE WEEKS WITH NO MAJOR TARGETS HIT. IF A CHANGE OF COMMANDERS, LIKE THOSE MADE IN MORAZAN WITH MONTERROSA AND IN CHALATENANGO WITH OCHOA, COULD BE MADE IN USULUTAN AND SAN VICENTE, I THINK THE SALVADORAN MILITARY COULD CONTAIN THE GUERRILLA PROBLEM. THE PROBLEM WILL ALWAYS BE THERE, BUT IT COULD BE CONTAINED AND THE GOVERNMENT COULD THEN TURN TO RESTORING THE ECONOMY.

HOWEVER, THREE OTHER CHANGES SEEM TO BE EMERGING AND I AM NOT SURE WHAT THEIR RESULT WILL BE.

-THE REACTIVATION OF THE WESTERN FRONT WITH A REACTIVATION OF THE GUATEMALAN RESUPPLY LINES TO EL SALVADOR WILL CREATE A NEW PROBLEM FOR THE GOVERNMENT.

-HONDURAS SEEMS TO BE UNDERGOING A CHANGE IN ATTITUDE TOWARDS THE UNITED STATES. THIS, COUPLED WITH WHAT SEEMS TO BE AN INADEQUATE PERCEPTION ON THEIR PART AS TO THE GUERRILLA PROBLEM ALONG THE SALVADORAN BORDER, AND THEIR INABILITY TO RESPOND TO INTELLIGENCE DATA, LEAVES THE SALVADORAN GUERRILLAS WITH SANCTUARIES IN WHICH TO CONTINUE TO REGROUP, RESUPPLY, AND CONCENTRATE. AS HAS BEEN SEEN WITH THE GOVERNMENT SWEEP OPERATIONS AND PROPER USE OF INTELLIGENCE DATA, THE GUERRILLAS CANNOT BE ALLOWED TO CONCENTRATE IN LARGE NUMBERS IN INACCESSIBLE AREAS.

- THE CONTADORA PROPOSAL AND DUARTE'S U.N. SPEECH ARE TIED, I THINK, TO REPORTING FROM THE LAST EIGHT WEEKS. SOME OF THIS REPORTING I HESITATED USING AT THE TIME AND SOME OF IT LOOKED DUBIOUS AT BEST. HOWEVER, AFTER REVIEWING THE MATERIAL, SOME

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GENERAL THEMES SEEM TO BE EMERGING.

WITH DUARTE GAINING INTERNATIONAL LEGITIMACY, THE GUERRILLAS SEEM TO BE TURNING TO A REACTIVATION OF THE LABOR FRONT. THIS IS TO BE DONE IN ORDER TO REGAIN DOMESTIC AND FOREIGN SUPPORT BY AROUSING DISSATISFACTION WITH ECONOMIC PERFORMANCE. THEY VIEW THIS AS A KEY VULNERABILITY OF DUARTE'S GOVERNMENT.

[REDACTED] REPORTING OF A PCES STUDY ON THE ECONOMY INDICATES THAT THE PCES URGED THE GUERRILLAS TO ACCEPT NEGOTIATIONS WITH DUARTE BECAUSE THE GUERRILLAS' MILITARY COMPONENT COULD NOT WIN AN OVERALL VICTORY AND IF GUERRILLA OPERATIONS CONTINUED AGAINST ECONOMIC TARGETS, THE ECONOMY WILL EVENTUALLY BE OF LITTLE USE TO EITHER THE RIGHT OR THE LEFT.

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THE PCES STUDY PROPOSED THE FOLLOWING PLAN:

- USE INTERNATIONAL PRESIDENTS AND FOREIGN GOVERNMENTS TO URGE DUARTE TO NEGOTIATE WITH THE GUERRILLAS. (WE HAVE SEEN THIS HAPPEN IN THE DISCUSSION WITH DUARTE AND BETANCUR FROM COLUMBIA.)

- USE HUMANITARIAN ORGANIZATIONS TO URGE DUARTE TO NEGOTIATE.

- USE INTERNATIONAL LABOR ORGANIZATIONS TO PRESSURE DUARTE TO NEGOTIATE. THIS WE SEE HAPPENING WITH THE SOCIALIST INTERNATIONAL INVOLVEMENT IN THE LA PALMA MEETING, AND A SHIFT OF EMPHASIS OF THE PART OF THE GUERRILLAS TO INTERNAL LABOR ORGANIZATIONS.

- USE MAJOR INTERNATIONAL CHURCH OFFICIALS TO PERSUADE DUARTE.

ONCE THE NEGOTIATIONS BEGIN HOWEVER, THEY WOULD SETTLE ONLY FOR POWER SHARING AS THE BASIS FOR AGREEMENT.

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[REDACTED] INITIALLY SHELVED, INDICATED THAT THE NICARAGUAN MILITARY AID TO THE SALVADORAN GUERRILLAS WOULD BE CUT BECAUSE OF NICARAGUAN AGREEMENT WITH THE CONTADORA GROUP. AN ADDITIONAL [REDACTED] REPORT INDICATED THAT THE GUERRILLAS WERE UNHAPPY BECAUSE THE NICARAGUANS HAD NOT CONSULTED WITH THE GUERRILLAS PRIOR TO THE FINAL DRAFT OF THE CONTADORA PAPER. THEY FELT THEY HAD BEEN SHUT OUT. THIS COULD ACCOUNT FOR THE SHIFT OF RESUPPLY TO THE GUATEMALAN BORDER WITH EL SALVADOR. ALSO, THE FMLN STRUCTURE HAS BEEN ON UNEASY FOOTING WITH THE NICARAGUANS SINCE THE U.S. INVASION OF GRENADA WITH SOME ELEMENTS MOVING TO MEXICO CITY. THE SALVADORAN GUERRILLAS+ EVALUATION OF THE CONTADORA AGREEMENT PUTS MEXICO, VENEZUELA, HONDURAS AND GUATEMALA IN THE UNUSABLE CATEGORY: MEXICO, BECAUSE THEY FEEL IT IS MOVING UNDER THE SWAY OF THE U.S. AND IS BECOMING MORE RIGHT WING; GUATEMALA, BECAUSE THEIR ECONOMY IS OKAY AND THEY PREFER NOT TO HAVE U.S. INVOLVEMENT IN THEIR COUNTRY; HONDURAS THEY FEEL IS UNDERGOING A POLITICAL CHANGE AWAY FROM THE U.S., BUT IS STILL RIGHT WING. VENEZUELA, THEY FEEL, IS TIED UP WITH ITS OWN INTERNAL POLITICS AND IS ALSO MOVING TO THE RIGHT. HOWEVER, THE GUERRILLAS FEEL THAT WITH THE NEW BARLETTA GOVERNMENT IN PANAMA, PANAMA CAN BE USED AS A BRIDGE AND A MEDIATOR IN NEGOTIATIONS WITH DUARTE. COLUMBIA, BECAUSE OF BETANCUR, COULD BE USED PUBLICLY AND HE IS A GOOD IMAGE MEDIATOR.

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THE FINAL PIECE OF INFORMATION ALSO DISMISSED AT FIRST, WAS [REDACTED] REPORTING THAT THE CUBAN PRESIDENT HAD ISSUED A STATEMENT THROUGH A RELIABLE EMISSARY URGING DUARTE TO NEGOTIATE WITH THE GUERRILLAS. WHAT EMERGED, OF INTEREST, WAS DUARTE'S RE'SPONSE IDENTICAL TO THE U.N. SPEECH HE MADE LAST MONDAY.

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I AM UNSURE WHERE ALL OF THE ABOVE WILL LEAD, BUT I AM SEEING A SUBTLE CHANGE ON THE PART OF THE GUERRILLAS ON THE BATTLEFIELD, IN PROPAGANDA ACTIVITIES, AND IN RESUPPLY. THIS COULD BE AN EFFORT TO ENTER NEGOTIATIONS WITH DUARTE ON A MORE EVEN FOOTING, OR IT MAY BE AN AWARENESS THAT NEGOTIATIONS USUALLY DO NOT BENEFIT THE HOST GOVERNMENT BUT THEY DO BUY TIME FOR THE GUERRILLAS TO WAIT OUT EVENTS THAT ARE UNFAVORABLE TO THEM. THE DESERTION RATE COULD HIT 25-30 PCT, BUT THIS WOULD STILL LEAVE THE GUERRILLAS A HARD CORE FORCE OF 5,000-6,000 HIGHLY TRAINED PERSONNEL. THE ONE THING ON THE SIDE OF ANY GUERRILLA MOVEMENT, IS TIME. THAT IS THE ONE THING DUARTE DOES NOT HAVE.

GUERRILLA ACTIVITY FOR THE QUARTER COMPRISING JULY, AUGUST, SEPTEMBER TIME FRAME REFLECTED THE FOLLOWING AVERAGES: 65 ACTIONS AVERAGED FOR JULY, 58 ACTIONS FOR AUGUST, 67 FOR SEPTEMBER, WITH HIGH LEVEL ACTIVITY BETWEEN 6-13 JULY (90), 8-14 SEPTEMBER (77) AND 14-21 SEPTEMBER (77).

GUERRILLA ACTIVITY FOR THE TWELVE WEEK PERIOD AVERAGED OUT TO 63 ACTIONS PER WEEK.

A. OBSERVATIONS

SANTA ANA: GUERRILLAS FROM CHALATENANGO DEPARTMENT THAT MOVED TO SANTA ANA DEPARTMENT RAN HIGH LEVEL PROPAGANDA ACTIVITY IN THE AREA RUNNING FROM SAN ANTONIO PAJONAL ON THE GUATEMALAN BORDER TO MASAHUAT AND METAPAN. GUERRILLA ACTIONS WERE CONFINED TO THE HIGHWAY RUNNING NORTH OUT OF SANTA ANA CITY. U/I AIRCRAFT ACTIVITY WAS REPORTED OVER METAPAN AND GUAJOYO. THIS COULD BE ASSOCIATED WITH THE REPORTED TWICE WEEKLY FLIGHT FROM THE PACIFIC OVER SONSONTE DEPARTMENT.

CHALATENANGO: DUE TO COL. OCHOA'S SWEEP OPERATION IN THE LAS VUELTAS AREA, THE GUERRILLAS MOVED NORTH/NORTHWEST TO THE AREAS OF OJOS DE AGUA, COMALAPA, AND DULCE NOMBRE DE MARIA. THESE GUERRILLAS HAVE BEEN REPORTED TO BE RESTING AND REGROUPING.

A HEAVY CONCENTRATION OF GUERRILLAS STILL EXIST NEAR BOTH DAMS, AND ALONG THE OLD RESUPPLY CORRIDORS RUNNING FROM LA VIRTUD IN HONDURAS TO CINQUERA IN CABANAS DEPARTMENT AND LAS VUELTAS IN CHALATENANGO DEPARTMENT. ONE ROAD BLOCK ACTION, POSSIBLY ASSOCIATED WITH LOGISTICS, TOOK PLACE ALONG THE RESUPPLY CORRIDOR BY 200 GUERRILLAS NORTH OF SAN JOSE LAS FLORES.

CORRECTION: HELICOPTERS REPORTED IN LAST WEEKS' SUMMARY TO HAVE BEEN SHOT DOWN SOUTH OF CHALATENANGO CITY CRASHED DUE TO MECHANICAL MALFUNCTION. HELOS WERE ASSOCIATED WITH CIVILIAN ACTIVITY AND THE CRASH REDUCED THE SALVADORAN HELO INVENTORY TO THIRTY-ONE.

AHUACHAPAN: NO CHANGE

SONSONATE: NO CHANGE

LA LIBERTAD: NO CHANGE

LA PAZ: ONE U/I AIRCRAFT WAS REPORTED TO HAVE OVERFLOWN

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THE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AND THIS ACTIVITY MAY HAVE BEEN ASSOCIATED WITH THE ACTIVITY REPORTED BY THE USS PAUL ON THE THIRD OF OCTOBER.

SAN SALVADOR: GUERRILLA ACITIVITY REMAINED CONSTANT ALONG THE TRONCAL DEL NORTE HIGHWAY. PROBING ACTION WAS REPORTED AGAINST ILLOPANGO AIRFIELD. GUERRILLA PRESENCE WAS NOTED IN THE SAN MARTIN AND GUAZAPA AREA.

CUSCATLAN: A HEAVY GUERRILLA PRESENCE WAS NOTED ON THE HIGHWAY BETWEEN SUCHITOTO AND SAN MARTIN. GUERRILLAS RAN HARASSING ACTION AGAINST SAN JOSE GUAYABAL.

CABANAS: NO CHANGE

SAN VICENTE: GUERRILLAS APPEAR TO BE MOVING BACK INTO THE CERRO SAN PEDRO CAMP SYSTEM FOLLOWING GOVERNMENT SWEEP OPERATIONS IN THE AREA. HEAVY GUERRILLA ACTIVITY CONTINUED FOR THE FOURTH CONSECUTIVE WEEK BETWEEN THE CITIES OF SAN VICENTE, ZACATECOLUCA AND TECOLUCA.

USULUTAN: GUERRILLA ACTIVITY REMAINED HIGH ALONG THE LITTORAL HIGHWAY BETWEEN THE LEMPA RIVER, JIQUILISCO AND PUERTO EL TRIUMFO.

GUERRILLA PRESENCE ALONG THE BAHIA DE JIQUILISCO INCREASED PROBABLY DUE TO ACTIVITY IN THE JUCARAN TRIANGLE ASSOCIATED WITH RESUPPLY BY SEA. SIX ERP LOGISTICS ASSOCIATED UNITS WERE NOTED.

SAN MIGUEL: NO CHANGE

MORAZAN: DIMINISHED GUERRILLA ACTIVITY WAS NOTED THROUGHOUT THE DEPARTMENT.

LA UNION: AFTER THREE WEEKS OF CONTINUED HIGH LEVEL GUERRILLA ACTIVITY IN NORTHERN LA UNION, ACTIVITY DIMINISHED CONSIDERABLY. THE PRIOR ACTIVITY WAS PROBABLY ASSOCIATED WITH AN EXPECTED AIR RESUPPLY DELIVERY. THE DELIVERY WAS PROBABLY COMPLETED AND THE LOW LEVEL OF ACTIVITY REFLECTS GUERRILLA MOVEMENT WITH THE SUPPLIES TO VARIOUS CAMP SYSTEMS.

(b)(1) [] REPORTING HOWEVER, DID INDICATE GUERRILLA RECON OF
(b)(3) NatSecAct [] PLANS TO ATTACK THE NAVAL FACILITY AT LA UNION. THE BASE WAS NOTIFIED AND WENT ON FULL ALERT. [] OVERFLIGHT OF THE AREA DID NOT REFLECT GUERRILLA PRESENCE OR ACTIVITY.

FOUR ERP RESUPPLY ASSOCIATED UNITS WERE PICKED UP BY [] BETWEEN EL CUCO AND TAMARINDO. TWO OF THE UNITS WERE AT SEA OFF PLAYA EL TAMARINDO.

II. GUERRILLA RESUPPLY:

A. ACTIVITY THE USS PAUL NOTED ON 3 OCTOBER, THREE U/I AIRCRAFT, HAS BEEN CATEGORIZED AND POSSIBLY ASSOCIATED WITH THE FOLLOWING:

-ONE OF THE AIRCRAFT WAS IDENTIFIED AS A HELO, POSSIBLY A MI-8 OR ALOUETTE. THE HELO WAS PAINTED OLIVE GREEN WITH RED STRIPES.

-THERE WERE NO GOVERNMENT OR PROJECT AIRCRAFT IN THE AREA.

-THE RAINSTORM PREVENTED RADAR OR CONCLUSIVE VISUAL IDENTIFICATION OF ALL THE AIRCRAFT.

-AN U/I AIRCRAFT OVERFLEW THE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT ON THE SAME DAY.

-THE FLIGHT PATTERN FOLLOWED BY THE SUSPECT AIRCRAFT WAS THAT ASSOCIATED WITH AIR RESUPPLY OF THE GUERRILLAS IN EL SALVADOR. THE CRAFT FLY 50 FEET ABOVE THE SURFACE ON AN EAST TO WEST TRACT, TURN INLAND AND DROP FOUR BUNDLES, AND THEN TURN 180 DEGREES AND RETRACE THE ROUTE BACK TOWARD NICARAGUA.

-THE DISTANCE FROM THE COSIGUINA PENINSULA IS WITHIN THE RANGE OF THE NICARAGUAN HELO INVENTORY. THE TRIP, WHILE LENGTHY, IS ENTIRELY FEASIBLE BECAUSE OF SALVADORAN INABILITY TO INTERCEPT SUCH FLIGHTS.

B. TWO RESUPPLY CORRIDORS WERE NOTED BY THE FOURTH BRIGADE IN CHALATENANGO FOLLOWING SWEEP OPERATIONS IN THE EASTERN PART OF THE DEPARTMENT. THESE TWO CORRIDORS HAVE BEEN CARRIED BY BOTH DNI AND SOIC FOR THE LAST TWO YEARS. THE CORRIDORS RUN FROM LA VIRTUD IN HONDURAS THROUGH PORTILLO LA CRUZ, PORTILLO DE CHAPAMIS TO LAS VUELTAS OR FROM LA VIRTUD, HONDURAS THROUGH PANTANERA AND LAS ANIMAS, POTONICO, TO CINQUERA. PROJECT PHOTOGRAPHY CARRIES THE LATTER CORRIDOR ON LATE 1982 PHOTOGRAPHY.

C. U/I AIRCRAFT OVERFLEW GUAJOYO AND METAPAN IN SANTA ANA DEPARTMENT ON 2 OCTOBER IN THE AREA WHERE GUERRILLAS HAVE BEEN MOVING FOR THE LAST THREE WEEKS FROM CHALATENANGO DEPARTMENT. THIS FLIGHT PATTERN MAY COME OUT OF SONSONATE WHERE A TWICE WEEKLY FLIGHT WAS REPORTED IN LAST WEEKS' SUMMARY.

TEN ERP LOGISTICS ASSOCIATED UNITS WERE NOTED IN AN AREA EXTENDING FROM THE BAHIA DE JIQUILISCO TO PLAYA EL TAMARINDO BEGINNING AROUND THE 6 OCTOBER TIME FRAME. TWO OF THE UNITS PLOTTED AT SEA OFF THE COAST OF TAMARINDO IN THE GOLFO DE FONSECA. MAJOR GRIJALVA, FROM THE THIRD BRIGADE, HAD INFORMATION ON AN EXPECTED DELIVERY AND RECEIVED PERMISSION TO

RUN AN OPERATION IN THE JUCARAN TRIANGLE AREA NEAR 8811W 1310N USING THIRD BRIGADE ELEMENTS AND THE BARRACUDAS. NO FURTHER INFORMATION IS CURRENTLY AVAILABLE.

(b)(1) OTHER ACTIVITY NOTED ON THE COAST OF EL SALVADOR WAS PICKED
(b)(3) NatSecAct THE [REDACTED] IN SOUTHEASTERN LA LIBERTAD DEPARTMENT AND OFF ISLA SAN SEBASTIAN IN USULUTAN DEPARTMENT. THE FORMER INVOLVED PEOPLE MOVING SINGLE FILE TO AND FROM THE BEACH AREA. THE LATTER INVOLVED PEOPLE ON THE BEACH WITH NUMEROUS CAYUGAS.

III. NEW EQUIPMENT RECEIVED BY THE GUERRILLAS

NO NEW EQUIPMENT TURNED UP IN SOURCES REPORTING FOR THIS PERIOD.

IV. NICARAGUA RESUPPLY TO SALVADORAN GUERRILLAS

NO ACTIVITY WAS REFLECTED DUE TO LIMITED SATELLITE COVERAGE OF THE RESUPPLY POINTS.

(NOTE: DURING THIS REPORTING PERIOD, CUBAN NON-SCHEDULED FLIGHTS REFLECTED A DECREASE FOR THE THIRD CONSECUTIVE WEEK. HOWEVER, THE "CHICKEN FLIGHT" DID COMPLETE IT'S DELIVERY ON THE 10TH RATHER THAN THE 9TH OF OCTOBER.

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
