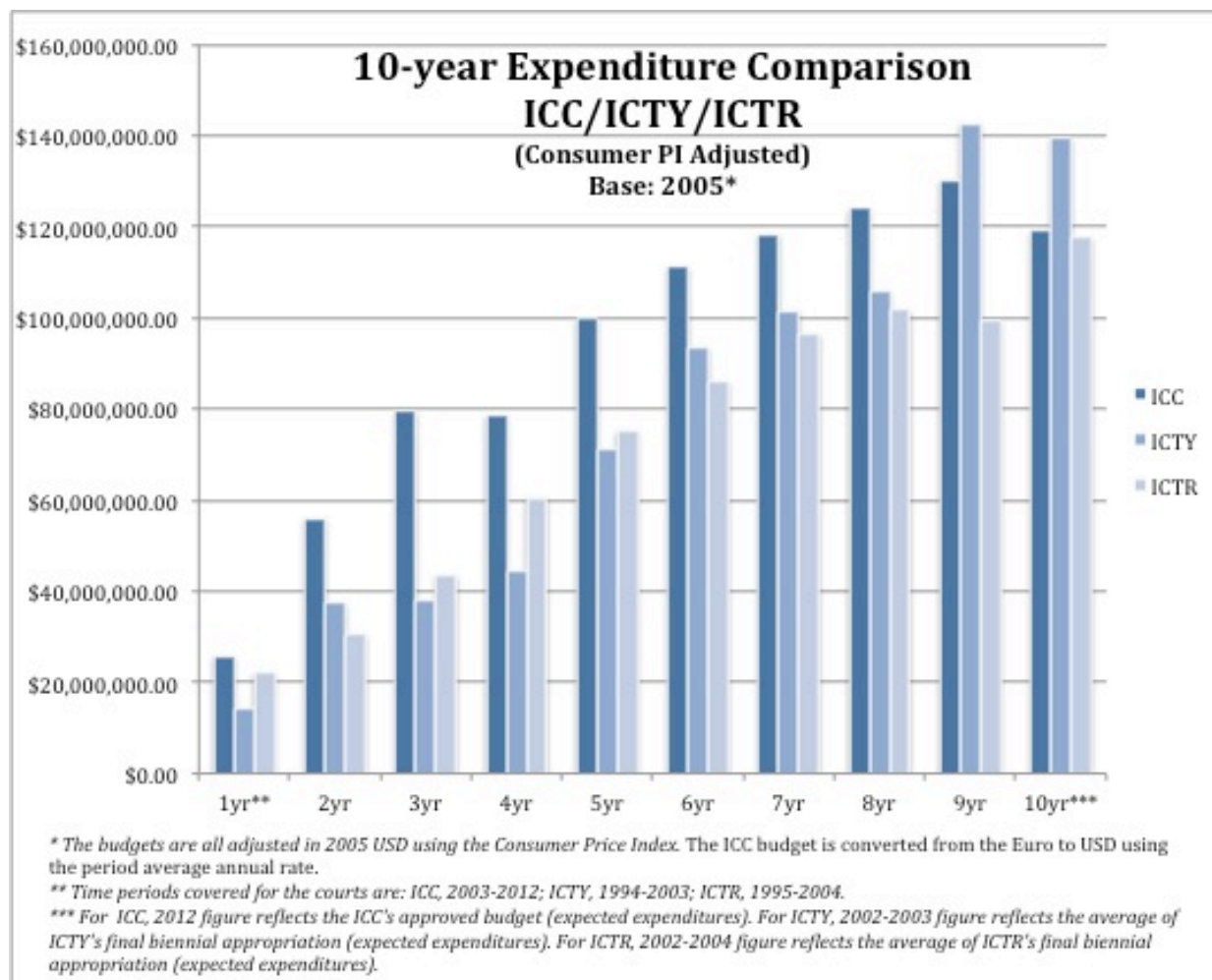


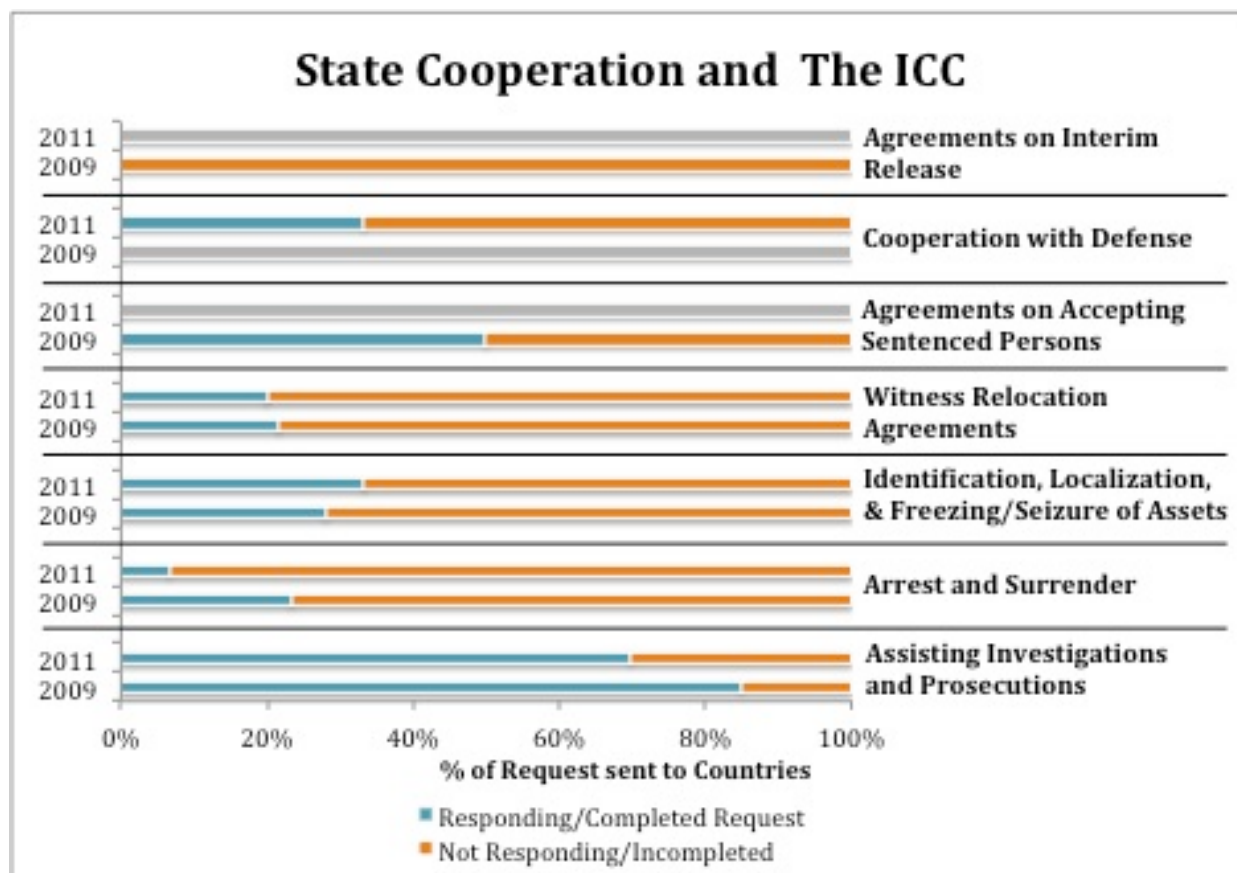
**Figure 3.2.** Achievements between courts in the first ten years<sup>763,764,765</sup>

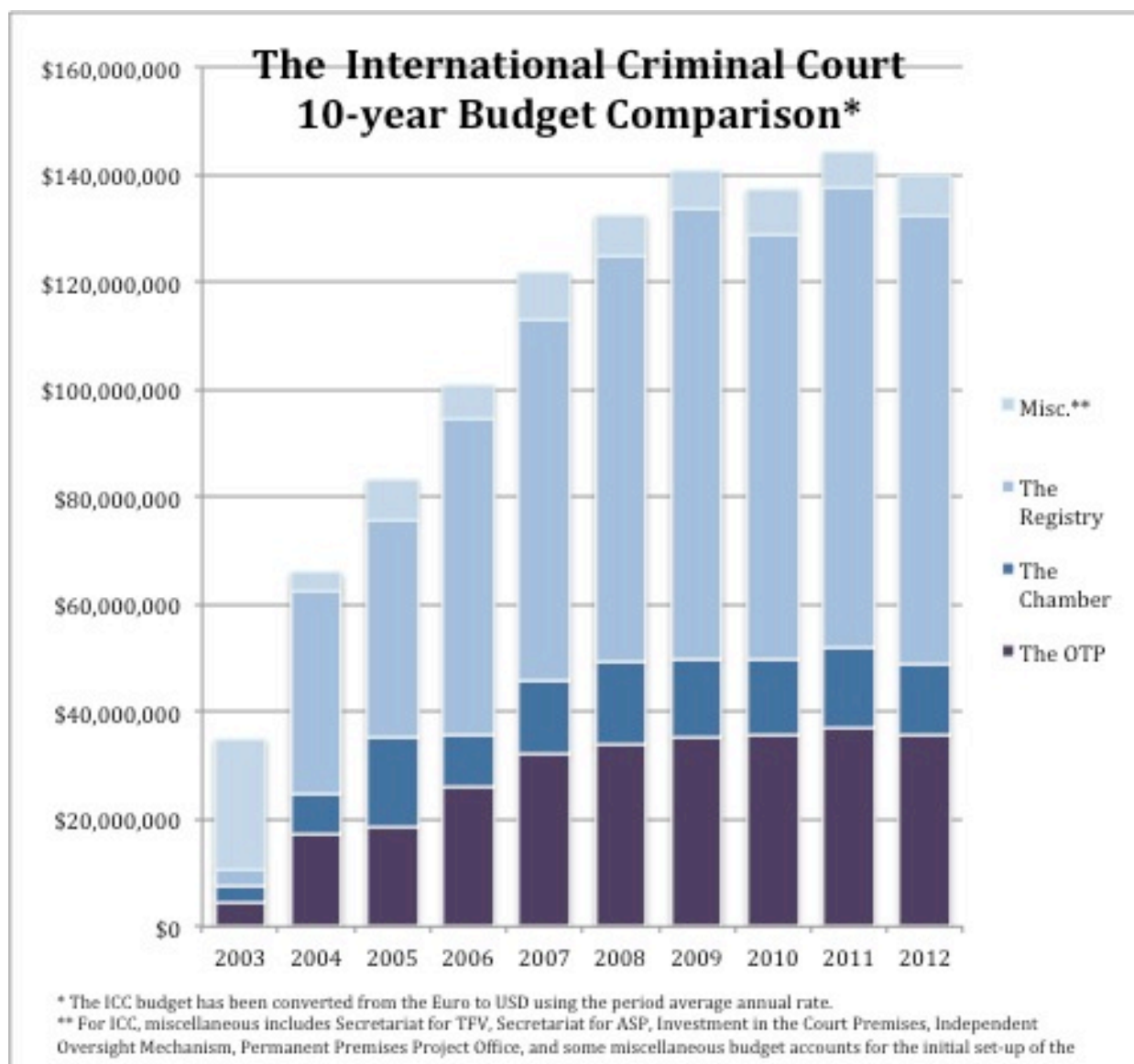
**Figure 3.2.** Comparison of expenditures in international criminal justice

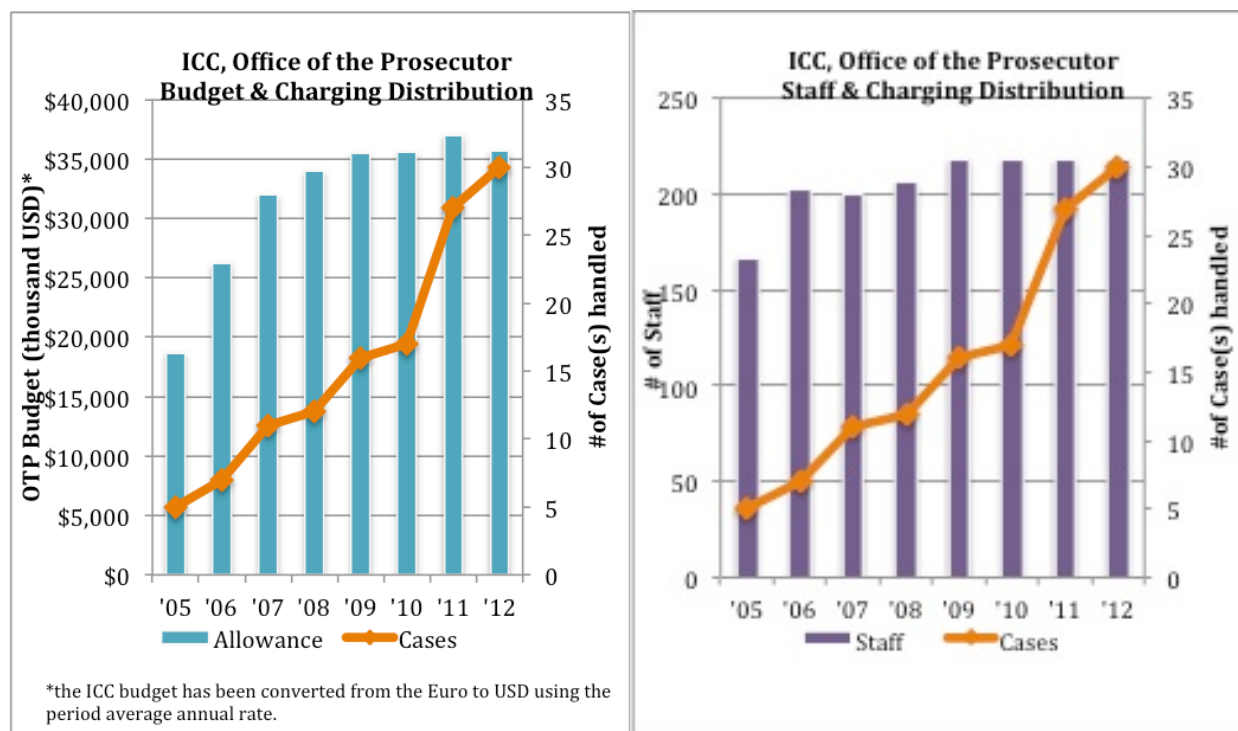
**Figure 4.1.** Response rates to court requests

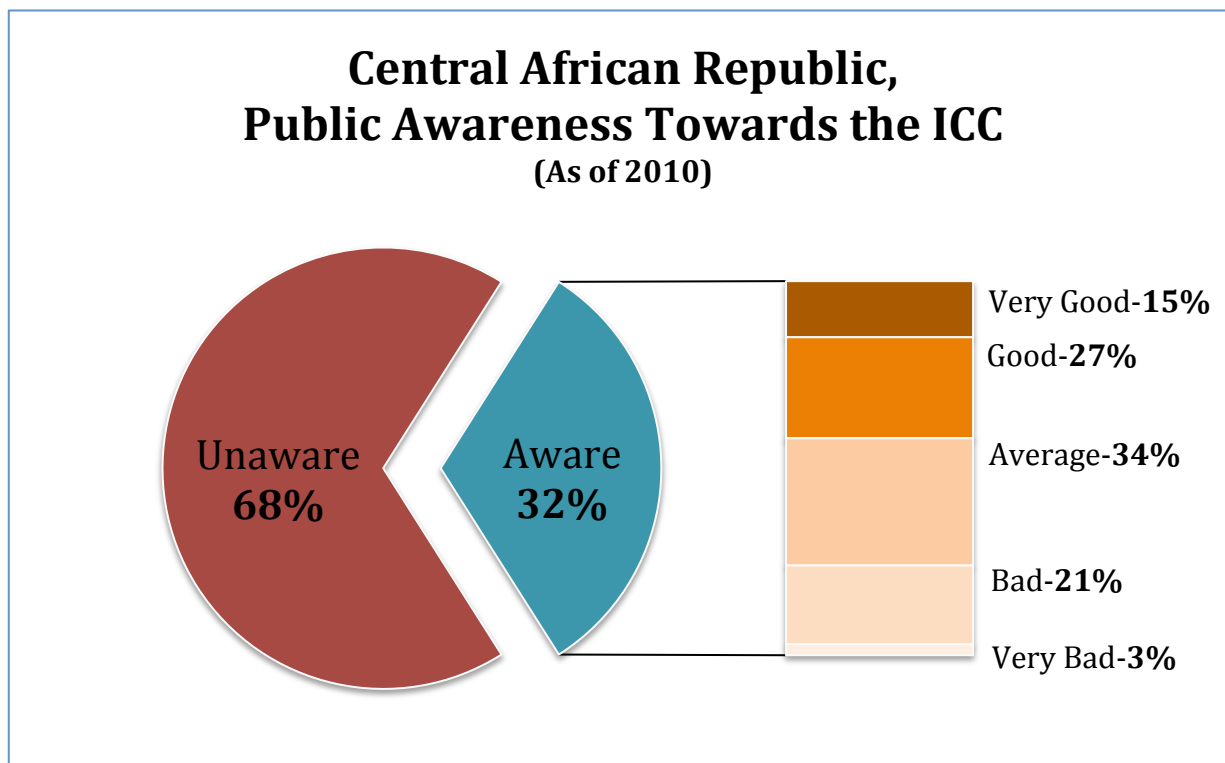
**Figure 5.1.** Ten-year budget progression of the ICC



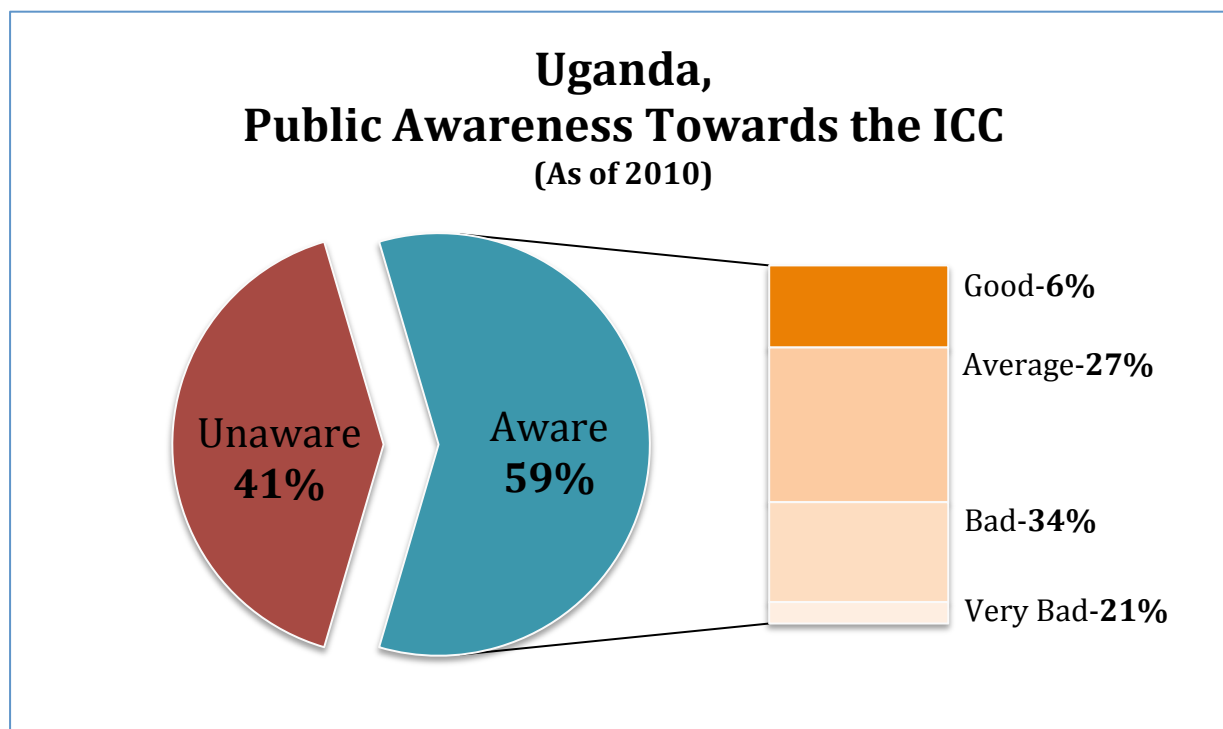
**Figure 6.** The ICC, Office of the Prosecutors budget and manpower distribution
